About the “C” session Instructor:

Our USDF “L” program “C” session instructor is Janet Foy, a native of Colorado. Her interest in dressage started when she lived in Oxford, England, and passed several British Horse Society Instructor Exams. As a rider, she earned her USDF Bronze, Silver, and Gold Medals. She is currently an FEI “4*” judge, USEF “S” dressage judge, and an USEF Sporthorse “R” breeding judge. Not only has Janet judged at all major shows in the United States including the national championships, but she has also judged national championships and CDI***/W in Guatemala, England, Colombia, Costa Rica, Barbados, Canada, Poland, Australia, and Mexico, as well as the FEI World Cup League Finals for the United States, Canada, and Australia. She was on the panel that selected the USA team for 2004 Athens, the 2006 WEG, the 2007 Pan American Games, 2008 Beijing and the 2010 WEG. She was appointed by the FEI to judge the 2010 Central American Caribbean Games in Puerto Rico.

Janet, who holds FEI Young Horse certification, has judged the USEF Young Horse and Developing Horse Championships several times. She is currently an apprentice FEI Technical Delegate, and a member of the Federation Dressage Committee, the International High Performance Dressage Committee, and the USDF “L” Faculty, via which she instructs federation judges training programs throughout the United States for dressage and sport horse breeding. She is a former member of the USDF Executive Board and the USA Equestrian Board of Directors. Janet also teaches clinics throughout the United States on a regular basis.
