1. LEVELS

Training through Grand Prix Levels, including GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes and Freestyle Classes, Management reserves the right to combine, divide and / or cancel classes.

2. AWARDS

Six ribbons in each class.

NEDA medals for **65%** or higher for first place in class

Ann Villani Adult Amateur High Point Award. Trophy and \$100 prize for highest scoring AA rider in any class held on Saturday excluding Freestyle & Young Horse Classes.

The Marshfield Agriculture and Horticulture Society Award. Trophies awarded to the highest scoring AA & highest scoring JR/YR of either competition, excluding Freestyle and Young Horse Classes.

3. ENTRIES

A separate entry must be completed for each competition.

Online entries can be done through www.horseshowoffice.com accessing directly or through Spring Show page on NEDA website www.neda.org. Or snail mail, fax or email entries to Show Secretary with complete payment, and negative Coggins (within one year). Entries received by Secretary prior to Opening Date will be held for five days before processing. Entries are limited and processed in order that complete and fully paid entry is RECEIVED by Secretary (not postmark date). Show Secretary reserves the right to delay processing incomplete entries until information, signatures and payments are complete. Entry will fall in priority, thereby falling on to Wait List. Each entry requires three signatures the word "same" is not acceptable. Person signing as trainer must be an adult on grounds. Copy of USEF& USDF card required for members, also copy of USDF Participating Member card plus USDF and USEF Horse Registration required for GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes.

All horses (including non-compete horses) must have documentation of EIV and EHV vaccinations according to GR845. Current documents must be available at show and presented if requested by Show Management. Current Coggins will be accepted in separate mailing but must be received before show. Make checks payable to NEDA. Credit Cards (Visa/MC) are accepted, and must be used when sending entry via online, fax or email entries. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Neither refunds nor schedule changes for competitor entry error. No number deposit required.

NEDA membership for current year may accompany entry with separate payment.

Email will be sent to confirm entry has been accepted. Please include accurate Rider and Owner email addresses.

4. FEES

Office Fee

\$35 per entry

Entry Fees:

\$45 Training through Second Level

\$50 Third through Fourth Level

\$75 All FEI Classes

GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes add \$15 to Entry Fee

Penalty Fees:

\$30 Penalty fee must be paid in following situations:

Entry received after closing date.

Non-negotiable payment, one fee for each entry for which payment is denied.

Each change to a scheduled ride after Closing Date or at show (unless filling a scratch at show where regular entry fees apply. Fees for unscratched rides cannot be used as credit).

Schooling Fees:

\$30 plus completed Entry with signatures, Coggins and full payment including Office Fee; USEF Drug Fee is not required.

Refunds:

Full refunds minus Office Fee will be given until Closing Date **No refunds after Closing Date, May 11, 2018 including for "acts of God" which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.**

All refunds will be credited to credit card when applicable. Others will be mailed to the party that paid for the entry.

5. TIMES

Times will be emailed. Official times will be posted on the NEDA web site www.neda.org. No times will be given over the phone. Times will be posted at Show Office at Noon on Friday June 1, 2018

6. STABLING

\$150 for duration of show.

Stalls will be available after 1:00 PM on Friday afternoon until 7:00 PM Sunday.

Approximately 180 permanent 10x10 stalls, with full split doors available on grounds. No bedding will be provided. Stalls will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

Include separate \$50 check **per stall** (including tack stalls) cleaning deposit made out to NEDA, which will be destroyed after stall is **stripped** by competitor and inspected.

The roof does not overhang the stalls so protection from the weather for equipment will need to be provided or consider a tack stall if available.

Credit Card only, No COD. Call to arrange delivery to Marshfield Fairgrounds.

Sharps containers are located on the road side of barns. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

8. DIRECTIONS

From the West: Take Rte.95 south to Rte.93 north to Rte.3 south. At exit 12 off of Rte.3 turn right at lights (east

on Rte. 139), at 4th set of lights, 2.7 miles, turn left on the Rte.3A north. The Marshfield Fair is one block on the right. Turn right on to So. River St. Enter Fairgrounds at Gate E

From the North: Take Rte.93 south to Rte.3 south. At exit 12 off of Rte.3 turn right at the lights (east on Rte.139), at the 4th set of lights, 2.7 miles, turn left onto Rt. 3A north. The Marshfield Fair is one block on the right. Turn right on to So. River St. Enter Fairgrounds at Gate E.

From the South (Providence Area): Take Rte.95 north to Rte.93 north to Rte.3 south. At exit 12 off of Rte. 3

turn right at lights (east on Rt.139), at the 4th set of lights, 2.7 miles, turn left onto Rt. 3A north. The Marshfield Fair is one block on the right. Turn right on to So. River St. Enter Fairgrounds at Gate E.

From The Worcester Area: Take Rte.90 east/Mass Pike to Rte.95 south to Rte.93 north to Rte 3 south. At exit

12 off of Rte. 3 turn right at the lights (east on Rt.139), at the 4th set of light 2.7 miles; turn left onto Rte. 3A north. The Marshfield Fair is one block on the right. Turn right on to So. River St. Enter Fairgrounds at Gate E.

9. FOOTING

All competition rings are large 60x20 well drained outdoor stone dust arenas. One large stone dust and one sand warm up

10. ENTERTAINMENT
