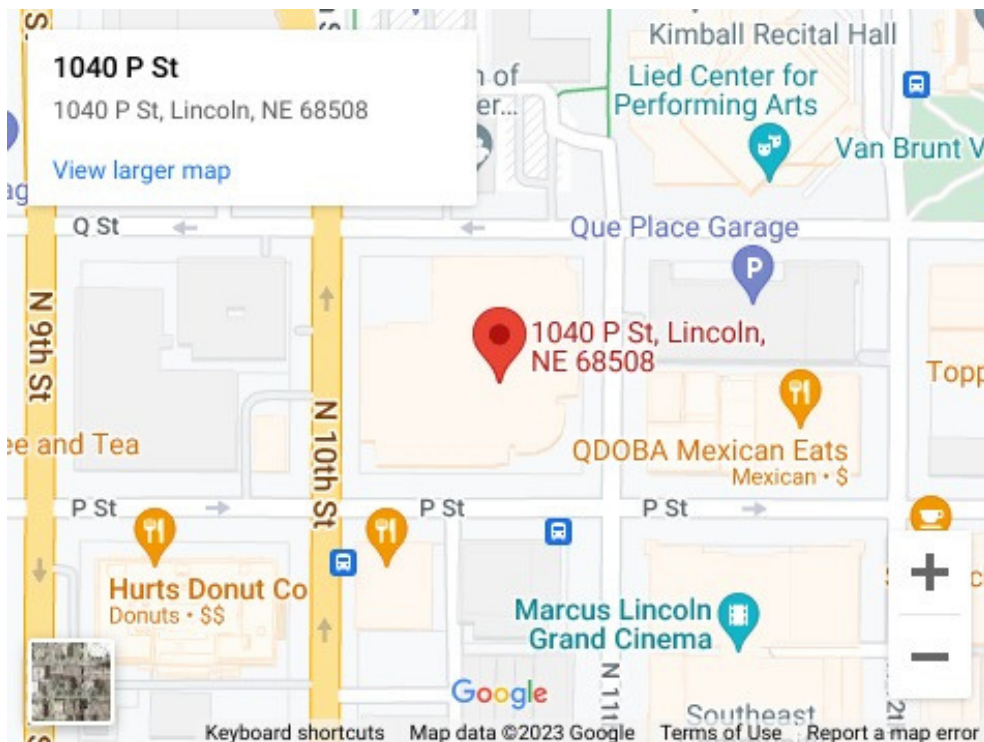

### **Dr. Ihrig is returning to NHPCA in 2025!!**

Dr. Tim Ihrig is an internationally recognized expert in palliative and hospice medicine known for combining clinical and administrative experience to create health and social care systems that reliably deliver high-value outcomes in a financially sustainable manner for seriously ill populations. His innovative approach to communication is a recognized model for academic training and transforming the paradigm of care for the most vulnerable and ill individuals.

He is the CEO of Ihrig MD & Associates. He founded the Inflection Period Coalition - a consortium of providers, scientists, academics and scholars developing allied health / medical curriculum and working to identify biologic markers that correlate with physiologic capacity to better serve individuals in the last chapter of their lives based on need and what is sacred to each.

He is the former Chief Medical Officer for Crossroads Hospice and Palliative Care, the seventh largest community and home-based hospice organization in the U.S., and Medical Director of Palliative Medicine / Hospice and member of the Board of Managers at the Trinity Regional Medical Center (TRMC) and Iowa Methodist Medical System of the Unity Point Health System.

His featured TED talk has been viewed more than 1.5 million times and National Public Radio's, "All Things Considered" featured him in a story on the development and transformative nature of his philosophy of care. He is the co-author of Palliative Care and Symptom Management, and is featured in The Art of Healthcare Innovation: Interviews and Industry Insights from 35 Game-Changing Pioneers.

A native of Minnesota, Dr. Andrew Mayo was inspired to pursue a career in medicine by his family's long history of dedication to community healthcare and innovation. After completing his family practice residency at Bethesda Hospital in St. Paul, Minnesota, Dr. Mayo spent 17 years practicing in St. Croix Falls, Wisconsin with an emphasis in geriatrics. Dr. Mayo has served on clinical and hospital leadership boards, and as Medical Director for Luck United Pioneer Home, and Frederic Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. In 2014 Dr. Mayo joined St. Croix Hospice as an Associate Medical Director, where he is now Chief Medical Officer. In 2023 he was recognized as one of Becker's Hospital Review's "110 CMOs to Know." Dr. Mayo received his undergraduate degree from St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota, and went on to study medicine at the University of Minnesota-Duluth. Dr. Mayo continues to pursue additional medical training and has Hospice Medical Director Certification.

Dr. Paulmeyer is a Board-Certified Internal Medicine physician serving as the Medical Director at Cottonwood Hospice. He graduated from UNMC in 2012, and was accepted into the UNMC Internal Medicine Residency and Primary Care Program, a program with a focus on training the next generation of rural primary care physicians.

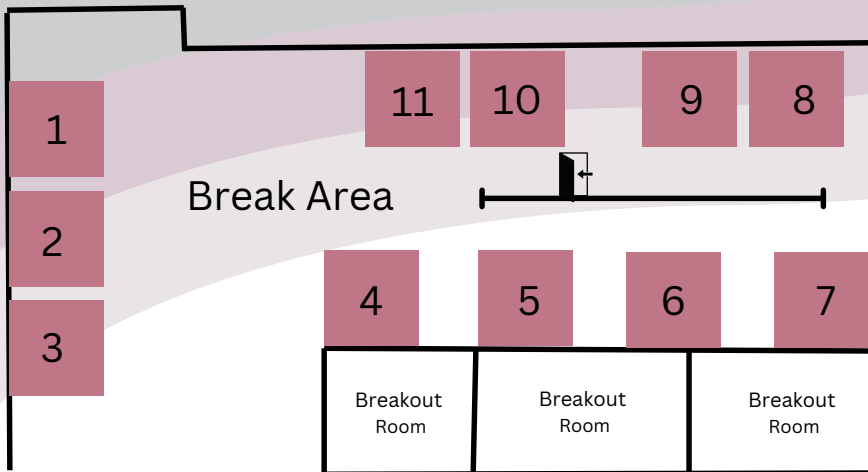
