Follow-up from Madeline through email, 3/4/2024:

I passed along the feedback you shared with me on our last call regarding some of the inconsistencies between what is shown on the INFO button versus what is in the TOC for certain online treatises. A few of them are errors and we will correct those; others are like that due to inconsistencies inherent in the BNA material dates and when the updates come out. We will make sure going forward that they are as consistent as possible. **Also, we are not planning to retrospectively upload editions of certain treatises that are “born digital.” The example that we looked at – Privacy in Employment Law – shows the 5<sup>th</sup> edition online, but we no longer have the previous electronic editions to upload. It would prove nearly impossible (even with huge servers) to capture and preserve previous editions of all our online treatises.**

The links for our archived materials that were provided by BLAW to AALL members (thanks to Susan de Maine’s urging) are not being updated at this time.
