FenStar® Certification

Attention FenStar® Licensees, all manufacturer folders have been created on the FenStar Document Uploading SharePoint. If you have not received the Welcome Letter from FenStar Staff or are having issues accessing your document uploading folder, please contact FCP@nfr.org for assistance.

Please begin uploading the required documentation (outlined in the checklist attached to the welcome letter) for FenStar certification as soon as possible. We are currently certifying product lines from participants who have uploaded all required certification documentation. FenStar Staff will be reaching out to all participants who have either not uploaded the required documents or are missing elements required for certification.

If you have not yet signed and returned your FenStar License Agreement, your organization has been reported as a non-compliant partner to ENERGY STAR Enforcement.
