FELLOWSHIP OVERVIEW

Type of program: Postgraduate APP Fellowship in Hospital Medicine with a concentration in Postacute Care

Number of learners: Two fellows per year

Length: 12 month full-time program, 40-50 hours a week

Didactic teaching: 260 protected learning hours (approx 5 per week)

Clinical practice: 1,700 clinical/mentored hours

Stipend: \$61,000 - \$94,500 per year plus UNMH benefits

CURRICULUM

- Length: 12 month full-time program 50-60 hours a week
- Fellows will participate in clinical and didactic experiences enriching their development in the field of Hospital Medicine with a concentration in Postacute Care.
- Five training blocks: Boot camp, Postacute Care, Inpatient Internal Medicine rotations, admissions, overnight cross cover and electives in hospital medicine.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- NP (FNP or ACNP) or PA and must hold NM state licensure/eligible and national certification/eligible.
- Applicants must be willing to travel to UNMH for an in-person interview at their own expense.
- Application period opens: June 1, 2018
- Application due date: July 31, 2018
- Potential APP fellows are organized, self-motivated, possess a passion for learning, and are prepared to embrace a fast-paced and multidisciplinary healthcare environment.
