Legislature postpones action on LB 1130 and LB 947.

Dear Friends,

As many of you may know the Nebraska Legislature adjourned Sine Die last Wednesday, April 18th. This year the Nonprofit Association of the Midlands took positions on two bills that would have significantly increased reporting requirements for some nonprofits and negatively impacted revenue for the nonprofit sector as a whole.

- **[LB 1130](#) - Indefinitely postponed (NAM Opposed)**
 - Provide a disclosure requirement for certain tax-exempt organizations under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act
- **[LB 947](#) - Indefinitely postponed (NAM Opposed)**
 - Adopt the Nebraska Property Tax Cuts and Opportunities Act, change income tax rates, and eliminate certain exemptions and credits
