## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please complete the application by typing or printing legibly. Only complete signed applications with all required documentation will be considered. Please submit the following items with this completed application form.

- An official copy of your previous year's transcripts of grades from current of last school attended along with a copy of your Fall 2020 transcripts of grades.
- Three original letters of recommendation from individuals who are not related to the application. One must be from a faculty advisor. All must be in original form, and must be signed and addressed to the Scholarship Selection Committee at the address noted above.
- A personal introductory letter addressed to the NSPS Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, not to exceed 850 words on a single-spaced paper, indicating why you chose your current field of study and any commitment to furthering your education beyond your current degree program. The letter should also include any involvement in community activities, extracurricular school activities, any awards and honors you have received, your career goals, any information on significant financial difficulties you are experiencing, and why you feel you should be selected to receive the scholarship.
- A copy of driver's license or other State-Issued ID (copies of both front and back).
- A copy of course syllabus or program course catalog showing specific course or subjects required by Scholarship.

**NOTE: THE APPLICATION AND ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE ADDRESS LISTED ABOVE BY FRIDAY, JANUARY 22, 2021. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

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## 2021 NSPS and AAGS Scholarships (you may apply for more than one scholarship on this application)

### Category 1: Students enrolled in (2) two- year degree programs in surveying technology.

- Berntsen International Scholarship in Surveying Technology (\$2000)

### Category 2: Only Students enrolled in, or accepted to, a graduate program in geodetic surveying or geodesy.

- American Association for Geodetic Surveying Graduate Fellowship (\$2000)

### Category 3: Students enrolled in (4) four-year degree programs in surveying (or in closely related degree programs such as geomatics or surveying engineering.)

- AAGS Joseph F. Dracup Scholarship (\$2000) Preference will be given to applicants enrolled in programs with significant focus on geodetic surveying
- NSPS Scholarship (\$2000)
- Nettie Dracup Memorial Scholarship (\$2000) Open only to undergraduate students that are enrolled in an ABET accredited Geodetic Surveying Degree program. (Prior recipients of this award are eligible.)
- Schonstedt Scholarship in Surveying (\$2000) Preference will be given to those students enrolled in their Junior and Senior academic years.
- Walter Robillard Scholarship in Surveying (\$2500) Open to any full-time undergraduate student enrolled in a (4) four-year ABET accredited surveying, geomatics, or geodesy college or university program.

### Category 4: Students enrolled in (2) two or (4) four-year surveying (and closely related) degree programs, either full or part-time.

- New Jersey Society of Prof. Land Surveyors Scholarship for Land Surveying Education (\$5000) Open to students in either a (2) two or (4) four year ABET accredited program in land surveying or a closely related field. Preference will be given to New Jersey residents.
- Cady McDonnell Memorial Scholarship (\$2000) Open only to female students enrolled in a (2) two or (4) four-year surveying or related degree program and are legal residents of one of the following states: AL, AZ, CA, CO, HI, ID, MT, NV, NM, OR UT, WA, and WY. – Must Include proof of legal residency with the application.
- Tri-State Surveying and Photogrammetry Kris M. Kunze Memorial Scholarship (\$2000) Students taking college level courses in Business Administration or Management. 1<sup>st</sup> Preference will go to PLS's or Certified Photogrammetrists-2<sup>nd</sup> Preference to certified land surveying interns – 3<sup>rd</sup> Preference to full time students in a (2) two or (4) four-year degree Surveying and Mapping program
- Lowell H. and Dorothy Loving Undergraduate Scholarship (\$2000) Open only to students currently enrolled in their junior or senior academic year of (4) four-year surveying program which must include any two of the following courses: Geometric geodesy, photogrammetry/remote sensing, or analysis and design of spatial measurement. Copy of program course catalog must be supplied with the application.
- Slovoj (Dr. Ing Desider E.) Scholarship (\$2000) Open only students enrolled in either a (2) two or (4) four-year undergraduate program at an ABET accredited college or university leading to a degree in Surveying Engineering
- Public Land Survey System Foundation Scholarship (\$1000) (2 year) Open to any student enrolled in a (2) two-year undergraduate degree program that includes the Public Land Survey System as a course or subject within a course as shown in the course syllabus or program course catalog, a copy of which must be submitted with the application.
- Public Land Survey System Foundation Scholarship (\$2000) (4 year) Open to any student enrolled in a (4) four-year undergraduate degree program that includes the Public Land Survey System as a course or subject within a course as shown in the course syllabus or program course catalog, a copy of which must be submitted with the application.
- Geographic and Land Information Society Scholarship (\$1000) Open to any student enrolled in either a (2) or (4) four-year degree program in Surveying or Geomatics. The student must have maintained a GPA of 2.8 or higher for the previous academic year of the program coursework and show an interest in integration of surveying and GIS. A copy of the previous year's official college or university program transcript must be provided with the application.
- West Virginia Society of Professional Surveyors Scholarship (\$1000) Open to students that are enrolled in either a (2) two or (4) four-year surveying degree program and are West Virginia residents or students enrolled in a West Virginia College or University.
