SESSION DESCRIPTION

1 in 7 children are victims of abuse by the time they are 18, this includes sexual abuse, physical abuse, emotional abuse & neglect. These are children who are coming into your primary care office every day. Families and problems are often complicated, and time is short. This session will help you to recognize high-risk situations in the office setting. Resources available, both in communities and statewide will be reviewed. Finally, outcomes of children who have been abused or neglected will be outlined, to help best understand the importance of early intervention and treatment.
