

Welcome to NWRA content tracks, a new continuing education member-only benefit!

What are content tracks?

NWRA recently organized all of its content into a [searchable database](#). With close to 400 individual pieces of content to reference we have created tracks to guide members toward specific topics. NWRA members can view and begin a track from the [member resources page](#), visible on the website once they are signed in. Once all track content is complete and all content-related online quizzes have been passed by the participant a certificate will be awarded. This certificate of continuing education may be used to meet license, permit, or other continuing education requirements.

How do I earn a certificate for continuing education?

Register for NWRA content tracks is free to NWRA members! Follow these steps to receive continuing education for a track.

1. Begin by signing in to your NWRA member profile
2. Visit the [member resources page](#) to navigate to your preferred topic track
3. Register for your preferred track
 - o Registration is free to members and only required if you desire a certificate
4. Watch each video, read each article and book chapter listed on the content list for this track to completion
 - o All content listed is free to read or watch with a current NWRA membership
5. Quizzes are grouped by content type (recordings, articles, book chapters)
6. There is one quiz for each content type, each quiz allows one attempt and requires an 80% or better score to pass
7. Once all quizzes for the track are complete NWRA staff will activate your certificate to your NWRA member profile
