The optional **STD Clinical Practicum** includes basic examination skills, skill development in sexual history taking, review of clinical case studies, and hands-on experience in the STD clinic and laboratory under the direct supervision of a skilled preceptor.

▼ COURSE AUDIENCE:

This course is designed for clinicians practicing in Washington who have completed the **Clinical STD Update course held in Seattle, WA on February 12 & 13, 2019**, and who have at least six months STD exam experience.

▼ COURSE PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN HOW TO:

- Elicit and record a focused sexual history.
- Perform thorough STD examinations on both male and female participants.
- Collect and perform STAT laboratory tests for the diagnosis of STDs.
