**THIRD AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE CONTINUANCE ORDER 2020-02
REGARDING ALL CIVIL CASES IN COURTROOMS 204, 205 AND 206**

Pursuant to General Administrative Order 2020-01 entered on March 13, 2020 by Chief Judge Timothy C. Evans regarding COVID-19 Emergency Measures:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- A. All municipal or law cases are continued by Order of Court until after May 31, 2020. New continuance dates on cases set for status, hearings or trials may be made by agreement of the parties. The party's attorneys shall efile any agreed orders for continuance within a date no more than 60 days after court reopens, with the clerk's office.
- B. In the event either party is pro-se and an agreed upon date is not practical, the case shall be continued by Order of Court, within 60 days of the court's resuming full operations. The clerk of the court shall notify the parties of the new court date for STATUS.
- C. All emergency motions shall be heard via Zoom in Courtroom 205, Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The emergency motion must be filed prior to presentment before the court and a courtesy copy presented to the judge.
- D. Any non-emergency motions to dismiss, agreed settlement orders or requests for special process servers, publication or agreed requests for pretrial settlement conferences shall be sent to the clerk's office via email:

- E. All cases set on Thursdays in Courtroom 204 and 205 shall be as follows:
 - 1. Evictions 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Cases held for trial at 10:30 a.m.
 - 2. Post judgment/collection cases shall be continued for Courtroom 204 at 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. and continued for Courtroom 205 at 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.

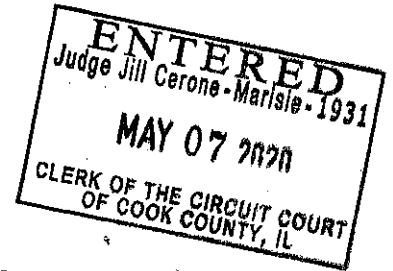
The clerk's office will notify parties of new date unless agreed continuance previously filed.

- F. All cases set for Thursdays in Courtroom 206 shall be as follows:
 - 1. Collection case status at 9:00 a.m.
 - 2. Previously heard 10:30 a.m. default call shall be set by the clerk's office for 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.
 - 3. Cases previously set on the 1:30 p.m. call will be divided by the clerk's office and heard at 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.

G. All plaintiffs shall notify all respondents of the new court date.
