AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE CONTINUANCE ORDER 2020-03 REGARDING ALL TRAFFIC AND MISDEMEANOR CASES

Pursuant to General Administrative Order 2020-01 amended May 28, 2020 by Chief Judge Timothy C. Evans regarding COVID-19 Emergency Measures:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

All in person traffic and misdemeanor matters are hereby continued until further order of court.

Only emergency matters and/or misdemeanors cases motioned up for plea agreements will be held via Zoom, with notice to all sides and all appropriate paperwork signed by defendant and returned to the clerk's office prior to the scheduled court date.

Any court date previously assigned in June will not be heard.

The clerk's office has notified traffic and misdemeanor defendants that they do not need to appear in June and they will send a future postcard specifying what future key date they need to appear (in person or by Zoom).

If the charges have been dismissed by MVNS, MSSOL or MSNP the defendants will be sent postcards that due to Covid-19 (March 17, 2020 – June 2020) the prosecutor will not proceed on their case and the charges were dismissed – no further action on their part is needed.

All traffic and misdemeanor cases (except for first time up or where good cause is shown) will be continued only for hearings, disposition (plea or trial) or compliance.

No cases will be continued for "status," except for the following:

- 1. awaiting lab reports or hospital records
- 2. scheduled drug and alcohol evaluation not completed
- 3. violations of supervision, conditional discharge or probation
