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<p><u>Pear Deck</u> is a live slides presentation tool that works with Google Slides or PowerPoint presentations and allows students to see the slides on their own devices. With Pear Deck, interactive slides can be added to solicit feedback, do a quick formative check, or just see how your students are feeling today.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stage 1 - Hoped for outcomes ● Investigation
<p><u>Flipgrid</u> is a website that allows teachers to create "grids" to facilitate video discussions. <p>Emaze is a web-based tool (and Chrome extension) that lets users create, save, and share presentations online.
