### Regulations

1. Must be completed in calendar year 2021
2. Design details and engineering construction details will not be reviewed
3. Title blocks should not be blocked out
4. All maps must bear the name and seal of a licensed land surveyor
5. Entries shall be submitted electronically
6. Entries must indicate category and be accompanied by an official entry form and fee of \$25.00 per category
7. One entry is allowed per category, per individual or company
8. All entries will be displayed at the annual conference
9. Winning entries will be announced at the annual conference
10. Winners will receive an award certificate, recognition in the Empire State Surveyor and entered in the national map contest administered by NSPS
11. Maps and fees must be postmarked by December 17, 2021. Late entries will not be judged. Fees are not refundable.
12. All decisions of the judges are final

### Judging Criteria

A map judging committee will review all entries based on the following:

1. Compliance with the current NYSAPLS Code of Practice
2. Originality: any unusual situation, depicted clearly, unusual techniques
3. Overall appearance: neatness, balance, consistency
4. Title: name well defined
5. Lettering: clear, unmistakable
