Evaluating Social Emotional Health Programs and Initiatives

The COVID-19 pandemic highlighted the need for data-driven school safety supports, initiatives and policies that focus on social and emotional health, and the promotion of welcoming and supportive schools. Research shows social and emotional supports are more effective if initiatives/policies are district wide, involve all school stakeholders, are well-resourced and are regularly assessed. Individual programs with fragmented approaches disconnected to the district's mission may not be as impactful.

Who Should Attend: School district leaders, school psychologists, school counselors, school social workers, DASA coordinators, building administrators and other school community partners.

- Learn about a range of school-based social and emotional supports, programming and initiatives.
