What do I need to do to get started?

1

Reach out!

- Email risk.eduimplementations@vectorsolutions.com to get started with the program.

2

Load your users

- The first step to getting started is using our template to load your users into the platform with our implementation team

3

Create your training plan

- Once your users are in the system, you'll want to create a training plan based on job role and location. This will populate into each user's profile so when they log in all necessary assignments are on their home page

4

Turn on notifications

- The Vector LMS has email notifications for assignments. Simply turn that on and you'll be good to go! (as a side note, send out something internally first so your staff know it's not spam).
