**PLEASE UNDERSTAND: OSHA DOES NOT APPROVE ANY PRODUCT. Likewise, the SED comment is not consistent with how SED works and is highly suspect.**

SED's guidance on polycarbonate products has been very consistent: "Individual districts must get written approval of evaluation and code compliance from their consultant architect or engineer."
