

Herbert G. Gingold, PhD, Receives Mitchell Award

Herbert Gingold was presented with the David Mitchell Award at the annual NYSPA Academic Division business meeting and luncheon held in late May at Brasserie Cognac in Manhattan. The Mitchell Award is named for the founder of the ancestral organization that became NYSPA and is awarded to individuals who have made unusually strong contributions to the organization itself. Herb was cited as someone who, despite difficult personal circumstances, has worked tirelessly on behalf of NYSPA navigating it through particularly problematic times.

In addition to his role as a recent NYSPA president (2017/2018), Herb has served in at least 20 other leadership positions in the organization. He is a clinical psychologist based in Kew Gardens, Queens, who works with diverse populations, including elderly, disabled, and LGBTQ individuals
