Call for Submissions for the Academy's "How-To" Video Series III

**A set of five short videos that will equip you
with the tools you need to report outcome measures with ease.**

The Academy has issued a request for proposals (RFP) for the development of five instructional videos and supplementary materials that demonstrate setup, administration, scoring, and interpretation of outcome measures for use in O&P clinics.

The ["How-To" Outcome Measure Videos](#) are designed to help O&P clinicians administer, use, and report outcome measures.

Up to \$1,700 in funding is available for each video, not to exceed \$8,500 total for all five videos. Interested individuals, clinical practices, O&P organizations, research universities, and O&P practitioner education programs are encouraged to apply to produce one or more outcome measure videos.

The videos will be added to the [Academy Paul E. Leimkuehler Online Learning Center \(OLC\)](#) in its course [Using Outcome Measures: A "How-To" Video Series](#). The videos and accompanying written materials will familiarize clinicians with measures best suited to O&P patients and settings and be a practical guide on how to administer measures, properly interpret results, and apply outcome measures in clinical practice.
