Highlights from the June 13th and September 12th, 2018
OASBO Board of Directors' Meetings:

- **Liaison Directors for Standing Committees** were approved earlier in order to ensure Chairs receive the information prior to their first meeting. It was suggested that an email be forwarded by the Liaison Director to introduce themselves.
- Many members must commit a number of hours to maintain their professional certifications. A template and guidelines will be developed for the **PD attendance Certificate**.
- **By-Laws Committee** will now be headed by the Executive Director and recommendations will be presented at the October 2018 meeting.
- An update on the **Privacy and Information Management (PIM) Network** was received. It was confirmed that new videos and posters were in process and would be available by the end of the summer.
- **The Student Information Workflow Advisory Committee (SIWAC)**, which is headed by the OASBO ICT committee, presented the report to COSBO, PCODE, ECODE and CODELF and also shared it with EQAO and MISA. The report will be posted on the OASBO Website in the Resource Library.
- An update on the **Policies Proposal** was received by the Executive Director. New terms of employment for staff and other policies will be reviewed on an established timeline.
- Planning of the **2018 Joint Chair and Directors meeting** will take place at the Hilton Mississauga / Meadowvale on October 18th and 19th, 2018. This is a great networking and sharing opportunity that allows committee chairs to work together on common projects or issues.
- The **2019 Annual Conference** will be held at Blue Mountain from May 8th to the 10th, 2019. Steve Shaw will chair the Planning Committee and is looking for new members to get involved and assist in providing quality PD sessions. Members will be asked to commit for a 2 to 3 year term and will include responsibilities such as conference theme, budget planning, format and speaker selection. They will review the feedback from the 2018 Annual Conference delegates.
