Hazardous Drug Acknowledgement Statement

I understand that working with hazardous drugs in a pharmacy healthcare setting might cause health issues such as rashes, infertility, miscarriage, birth defects, and possibly cancer.

I understand that the accidental exposure to some of these drugs might additionally cause irritation or damage to skin, eyes, or other exposed body parts.

I understand that the handling of bodily fluids (urine, feces, sweat, and vomit) or bodily- fluid-contaminated clothing, dressing, linens, and other materials comes with potential exposure to hazardous drugs.

I understand that the pharmacy OneWorld will follow reasonable policies and procedures in order to minimize my exposure to these drugs in accordance with commonly available information and guidance by such entities as the FDA and OSHA.

I understand that the pharmacy OneWorld will also provide for safety measures and appropriate personal protective equipment to help limit my exposure to, or limit the results of, accidental exposure to such drugs.

I also understand that these policies and procedures will be routinely reviewed and revised as needed in light of new information.

I have been provided with training concerning hazardous drugs, and have passed a test verifying my understanding of key information concerning them.

I understand that similar training will be repeated at least annually.

USP800 Training: Handling and Disposal



Objectives

- Review current USP800 guidelines on hazardous medications for safe handling of hazardous drugs to minimize risk of exposure to healthcare personnel, patients, and environment.
- Illustrate how clinic demonstrates compliance with USP800 guidelines involving hazardous medication administration & disposal.



USP800 – What is it?

- The USP chapter that contains guidelines for hazardous drug handling, administration, and disposal.
- Since it is below 1000 in the USP chapters it is enforceable by regulatory bodies.
- Joint Commission will be surveying for compliance.
- Implementation date of December 1, 2019.



Who does USP800 affect?

- Healthcare settings to include pharmacies, physician offices, clinics, veterinary offices, and other locations that handle hazardous drugs.
- The word “entity” in USP800 means your setting if you are handling hazardous medications

What medications make “the list”?

- NIOSH list of antineoplastic and other hazardous drugs in USP800 that pose hazard to *health care workers*.
 - Carcinogens, Teratogens, Reproductive toxicity, Organ toxicity, Genotoxicity, Chemical structure and toxicity that mimic existing drugs that are hazardous

Drugs found in the clinic that are on USP800 list (**see risk assessment list- this is kept in the Y drive under Nursing??**):

Methotrexate, all forms of birth control, medication with any type of hormonal component (to include any traces of these medications)



Containment strategies for USP800

- Engineering controls
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Work Practices

Work Practices for USP800

- Disposal: Section 11 of USP800
- The entity *must* establish SOP's for the labeling, packaging, transport, and disposal of HD's.
- 11.4 Disposal:Disposal of all HD waste, including, but not limited to, unused HD's and trace-contaminated PPE and other materials, *must* comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulation.



Transportation of HD

Pharmacy will place hazardous drug in plastic zip bag (Depo Provera, depo testosterone) or appropriate container indicating contents are hazardous drugs. This excludes items that are already commercially packaged and ready for patient use (ex: birth control pills, patches, rings, IUDs, and any creams or ointments).

Disposal - What determines the proper disposal method for a medication?

- RCRA (Resource Conservation and Recovery Act)
 - P-listed – Warfarin, Arsenic, Nicotine
 - U-listed – all in this category are toxic. Mitomycin, Mercury
- NIOSH (National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health)
 - A part of the CDC
 - A list of hazardous medications is published and risk categories are assigned.
- OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration)
 - An agency of the US Department of Labor
 - Responsible for providing a safe and healthful workplace



Who regulates and enforces proper medication disposal?

- The **Resource Conservation and Recovery Act** (RCRA) gives EPA the authority to control hazardous waste from the "cradle-to-grave." This includes the generation, transportation, treatment, storage, and disposal of hazardous waste.
- NIOSH and CDC may not be actual federal regulations but can be incorporated in state or local law or hospital policies
- Joint Commission considers proper disposal of hazardous medication waste as part of their Environment of Care standards
- FDA gives guidance
- State and federal government can enforce USP

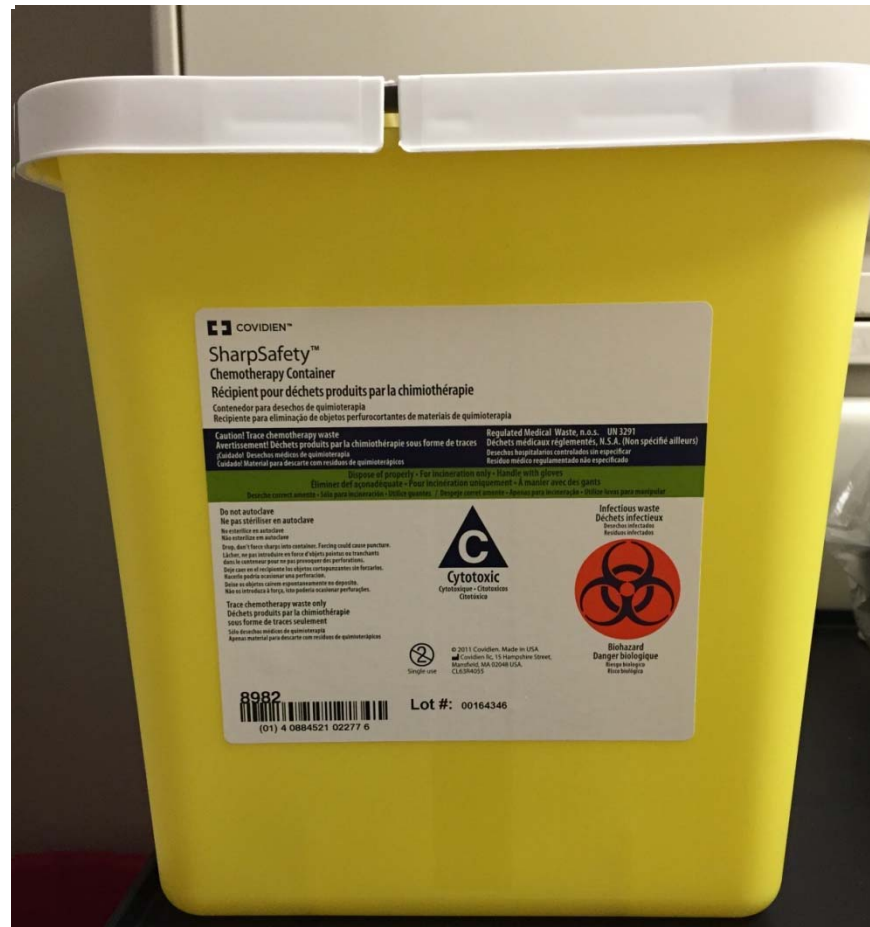
Hazardous Medication Waste

Trace waste

- Empty syringes or vials that contained any hazardous medication; and/or gloves used in preparation, administration or clean up.
- Must be discarded in a **YELLOW** hazardous waste bin (McKesson stocks these)

PPE Disposal

*Any gowns, masks, goggles, and gloves may be disposed of in the red biohazard tote in biohazard room.

*Any equipment used to clean up a spill must be discarded in red biohazard tote in biohazard room.

Another item for Hazardous Medication Waste





Spill Kit - How much volume does it hold?

- Contact the manufacturer for your kits but most kits hold approximately 750-1500 ml
- The ChemoSafety Spill Kit (CT4004) has a 788 ml capacity
- The ChemoBlock Spill Kit (DP5016K) has a 1624 ml capacity

After Spill is cleaned up remove respirator mask, safety glasses, any shoe coverings, gown, and outer pair of gloves. Discard in same waste bag.



Wearing only the inner gloves, close the bag and place it in the 2nd chemo waste bag. Remove gloves and discard in the chemo waste bag. Close bag with tie wrap.

Dispose of bag properly according to facility regulations.

POLICY –It is the policy of One World Community Health Center (OWCHC) to be in compliance with USP 800 chapter on Hazardous Drug.

PURPOSE –This document is designed to provide OWCHC leaders with the framework to guide the written documentation of the entities definition of USP 800 with regards to handling hazardous drugs in a healthcare setting.

REFERENCE: USP 795- 2014, **USP 800 - 2017**, 2019? NIOSH Hazardous Drug list 2016, OneWorld Hazardous Drug list.

PROCEDURES –

This USP 800 policy reiterates the commitment of OneWorld Community Health Centers, Inc. to comply all elements surrounding hazardous drugs with the standards issued by USP. It is the intent of this policy to promote awareness of hazardous drugs in our setting and the development of adequate internal controls and systems to handle them.

Scope and definitions:

USP 800 chapter discusses the practice and quality standards for handling hazardous drugs to promote patients safety, worker safety and environmental protection. The handling of hazardous includes the receipt, storage, compounding, dispensing, administration, transporting and disposal of sterile and nonsterile products and preparations.

List of Hazardous drugs:

The National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) maintains a list of antineoplastic and other hazardous drugs used in healthcare settings. OneWorld Pharmacy maintains a current NIOSH list. This list is reviewed and modified on an annual basis. The NIOSH list provides the criteria used to identify hazardous drugs. Some drug formulations such as tablets, capsules – solid, intact medications that are administered to patients without modifying the formulations may not pose a significant risk. However, dust from tablets and capsules may present a risk of exposure by skin and/or inhalation. OneWorld Pharmacy will

perform a risk assessment on these dosage forms to determine alternative contamination strategies and/or work practices. This assessment will address: type of hazardous drug, dosage form, risk of exposure, packaging and manipulation. This assessment will document any alternative containment strategies and/or work practices that will be implemented and used for specific dosage forms to minimize occupation exposure. This risk assessment will be reviewed and documented at least every 12 months. Whenever a new agent or dosage form is used, it will be reviewed to determine if a hazardous medication.

Safety requirements:

OneWorld Pharmacy will evaluate each drug and appropriate safety requirement on our annual risk assessment. This assessment will determine the level of personal protective equipment (PPE) required during the handling, receipt, transportation of hazardous drugs. **OneWorld Pharmacy** will utilize appropriate PPE such as chemo gloves that meet the (American Society for Testing and Materials) ASTM D6978 standards. All disposable PPE will not be re-used.

OneWorld Pharmacy will have PPE available for employees to utilize to minimize risks of exposure. The appropriate gloves, gowns, shoe covers, eye and face protective equipment will be made available if deemed necessary by our hazardous drug risk assessments.

OneWorld Pharmacy will have a spill kit available for cleaning or decontaminating any area that a spill may occur. Upon the discovery of a HD spill, the employee will notify employees in immediate area, notify management, obtain the spill kit and begin cleaning the spill. When cleaning the spill the employee will don the appropriate PPE necessary to ensure their safety and the safety of those around them.

Training:

OneWorld Pharmacy and Quality department will conduct training for USP 800 on an annual basis. All **OneWorld Pharmacy and clinical personnel** will be required to complete this training and it will be documented. Documentation of this training will be placed in the employees' personnel file. Each pharmacy **and clinical employee** will review and sign an acknowledgement statement that they have received annual training on USP 800, provided a list of all hazardous drugs housed in the pharmacy, **in clinic stock, delegated dispensing, and medication brought in by patient for administration and** are aware of risk associated with their job environment and have signed a hazardous drug acknowledgement statement.

OneWorld Community Health Centers, Inc. Clinical Education and Regulatory Quality Manager, **and the Director of Pharmacy** will be the designated authority figure to ensure USP 800 compliance. In the absence of the Clinical Education and Regulatory Quality Manager and/or Director of Pharmacy, the Associate Director of Nursing and Pharmacist in Charge will ensure USP 800 compliance ~~in the pharmacy department~~ at **OneWorld**

Facilities and engineering controls:

OneWorld Pharmacy will have a designated area for the receipt and unpacking of hazardous drugs. Signage will indicate this area and where hazardous drugs will be stored.

Receipt:

Delivery totes will be opened in the designated area, inspected for damaged products, and a determination of contents with relationship to hazardous drug classification will be made. During the unpacking of totes, hazardous drugs will be stored in their appropriate area. The employee will be required to don the appropriate PPE to minimize exposure.

Storage:

OneWorld Pharmacy will store Hazardous Drugs in their designated area in the pharmacy. This area will be above the floor area, on a shelf with a lip to prevent any spillage or leakage. Any liquid containing containers will be stored on the bottom row to prevent any cross contamination to any other dosage forms. Refrigerated items will be stored intermingled with other medications in the refrigerator. Any NIOSH group 1 hazardous drugs will be stored in an appropriate refrigerated area as outlined by USP 800 (negative pressure area with at least 12 air changes per hour.)

Handling, dispensing and transporting

All Hazardous drugs will be prepared in a designated area. Hazardous drugs that do not require any further manipulation other than counting or repackaging of final dosage forms, may be prepared for dispensing without any further requirements for containment unless required by the manufacturer or if visual indicators or hazardous drug exposures are present. (e.g. dust, leakage or broken capsules.) Counting or repackaging of hazardous drugs must be done carefully. Clean equipment should be dedicated for use of hazardous drugs and equipment should be decontaminated after every use. OneWorld Pharmacy personnel shall don the appropriate PPE while handling, dispensing and decontaminating the area and equipment.

OneWorld Pharmacy dispenses multiple types of dosage forms. Tablets and capsules will be counted on separate counting trays and use spatulas with the designation for hazardous drug use only. When pouring or mixing a hazardous drug a plastic-backed preparation mat should be placed on the work surface prior to mixing or pouring liquids into another container. Labels will be placed directly on commercially packaged medications that do not require any manipulation. Appropriate axillary labels will be placed on hazardous drugs containers or packaging. When transporting hazardous drugs between clinic, these drugs will be placed in a plastic zip bag (e.g. depo Provera, depo testosterone) or appropriate container ~~with~~ indicating contents are hazardous drugs. This will exclude items that are already commercially packaged and ready for patient use. (eg. Birth control pills, patches, rings, IUD's and any creams or ointments)

Spill control and decontamination:

OneWorld Pharmacy will train all pharmacist, clinical staff , and technicians on the proper way to clean and decontaminate following a spill of a hazardous drug. When a spill occurs, it should be evaluated to determine the scope of cleaning, decontamination, and exposure. A spill kit will be available in the designated area. ~~Pharmacy personnel~~ **All trained personnel** will be required to don the appropriate PPE. Sterile compounding is not performed at OneWorld Pharmacy. Therefore, OneWorld Pharmacy does not stock, administer or compound any NIOSH 1 antineoplastic hazardous drugs in the form of chemotherapy agents. N95 fit testing will not be necessary for pharmacy employees. The below table outlines appropriate PPE that should be worn in instances of a spill.

Decontamination and Cleaning:

OneWorld Pharmacy **and clinical personnel** will be trained to clean or decontaminate equipment after each use. OneWorld Pharmacy will utilize an appropriate method which may consists of a 10% bleach solution, soap, water or other agent to clean or decontaminate all counting trays, spatulas, hard surfaces and any other areas that have been in contact with a hazardous drug. Pharmacy employees will don appropriate PPE when decontaminating an area or equipment. After wiping off the cleaned or decontaminated area, the equipment must air dry for the designated amount of time required by the products manufacturer. The used cleaning equipment will be disposed in a manner that complies with all federal, state and local regulations.

Automated Dispensing:

Any tablet or capsule designated as an antineoplastic hazardous drug will not be placed in the automated counting machine.

Non-sterile compounding:

According to USP 795 on non-sterile compounding includes the reconstitution or manipulation of commercially available products that may require the addition of one or more ingredients. OneWorld Pharmacy does have several medications found on the NIOSH Hazardous Drug list. When reconstituting or pouring any medications on this list, pharmacy personnel will don the appropriate PPE as indicated on the medications risk assessment.

At the time of dispensing the prescription, the patient or the patient's agent shall be offered counseleding about proper use, storage, handling, and disposal of the compounded preparation. The patient will be advised to report any adverse events.

Disposal:

OneWorld Pharmacy will contract with a hazardous waste disposal company for disposing of hazardous medication waste and/or items that contain trace amounts of contaminated product. Items that may contain trace amounts of waste such as used gloves, gowns, face mask/shield, empty bottles, wipes, vials, syringes, packaging, used long acting reversible contraceptives, and empty pens etc. will be disposed of following appropriate hazardous waste trace amount guidelines set forth by the EPA. OneWorld Pharmacy will continue to utilize a reverse distributor for proper disposal of expired medications or destruction of medications.

OneWorld clinic will provide designated bins for disposal of hazardous medication waste and/or items that contain trace amounts of contaminated products. The hazardous medication waste bin will be distinct from red biohazard infectious waste sharps containers. Once the hazardous medication waste bins are full, they will be placed into the large red biohazard waste box. Trained personnel transporting used hazardous medication waste bins will don single use gloves.

Administration:

OneWorld clinical personnel will follow outlined administration guidelines provided in the risk assessment. These guideline may include;

- In clinic dispense- no single use gloves
- Single use gloves for preparation, administration, and disposal
- Chemo use gloves for preparation, administration, and disposal

Hazardous medication preparation for administration will occur on medication trays specifically marked for hazardous medications. Trays will be wiped down per instructions above in between each use.

When administering hazardous medication in oral form do not crush tablets, open capsules. If manipulation of a single does tablet or capsule is required, clinical personnel must don appropriate PPE and contain any dust or particles generated.

Patient Care Activity:

OneWorld clinical personnel will use Universal/ Standard Precautions when handling bodily fluids such as urine, feces, sweat, vomit, or body-fluid-contaminated clothing, dressing, linens.

Other Employee Responsibilities:

If an employee is unable to carry out duties related to the handling of hazardous medications due to conditions such as pregnancy, it is the responsibility of the employee to notify his/her direct supervisor. Reasonable accommodations will be made to change workplace responsibilities that enable the individual to maintain their employment.

It is the responsibility of the employee to notify direct supervisor of symptom complaints, physical findings, and laboratory values (such as blood count) that he/she may feel is related to handling of hazardous medications. An incident report should also be completed. Employee and direct supervisor should follow established injured employee protocol. OneWorld will track these complaints for trends and populations of workers. Occurrence of exposure related health changes should prompt immediate re-evaluation of primary preventive measures being used.

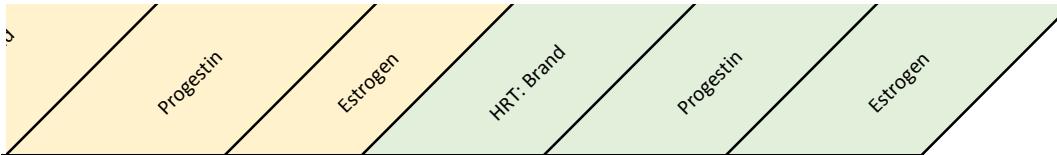
