Private Applicator	Immediate family member or a subordinate employee of a private applicator allowed to apply restricted use pesticide under the direct supervision of a private applicator	<p>No longer allowed to directly supervise immediate family member or a subordinate employee in the use of restricted use pesticide. Only a private applicator <i>shall</i>:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Perform pre-application activities involving mixing and loading the pesticide; (2) Applying the restricted use pesticide; (3) Perform other pesticide-related activities, including transporting or storing pesticide containers that have been opened, cleaning equipment, and disposing of excess pesticides, spray mix, equipment wash waters, pesticide containers, and other pesticide-containing materials. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Now only allows for the direct supervision of general use pesticide application

OhioPLANT is working to amend the new law to allow commercial and private applicators to directly supervise the use of restricted use pesticides by employees (and immediate family members in the case of private applicators) if the employee/family member receives training prescribed by the ODA director.
