This includes services available through the Texas Digital Library (the institutional repository, the data repository, and Vireo), and related topics such as copyright, open access, and scholarly metrics. Engages in scholarly collections analysis and develops and promotes research services specializing in assistance with digital tools for data analysis, management, visualization, and sharing. Collaborates with faculty and library staff to foster awareness of new technologies directly related to digital scholarship.



Duties:

- Coordinates the university's electronic theses, projects and dissertations, including format checks for dissertations and administering and troubleshooting Electronic Thesis and Dissertation (ETD) submission and management system (Vireo).



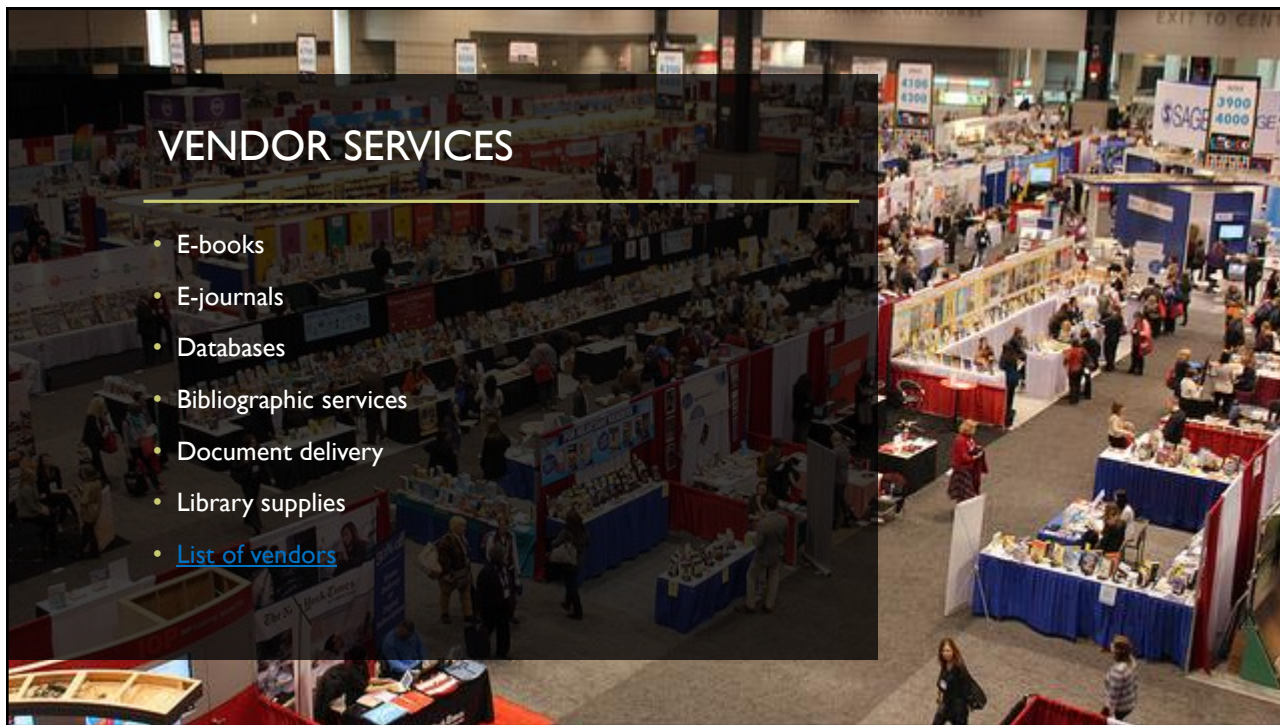

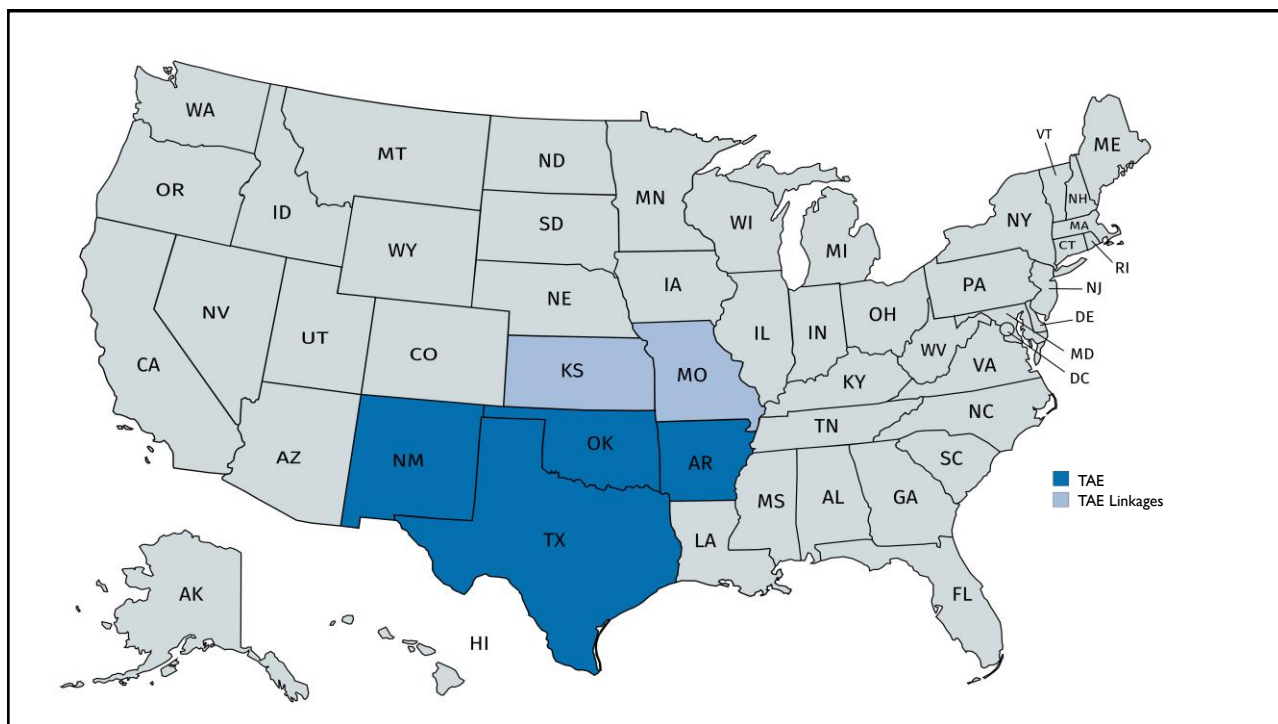

HOW TAE WORKS

- Bagged items are picked up by the assigned driver for your library
- Items go to the local hub for sorting by location # and hub information
- Items going to a different hub are transported overnight to other hubs and sorted again for delivery



TAE/TEXPRESS SERVICE

- Annual service period
 - September 2018 – August 2019
- Prorated fees available
- Service Options
 - 5-day service (M-F)
 - 3-day service (M,W,F)
 - 2-day service (T,TH)
 - Customized service, e.g., main library to branch libraries in same system, courier for 5 libraries in the same county

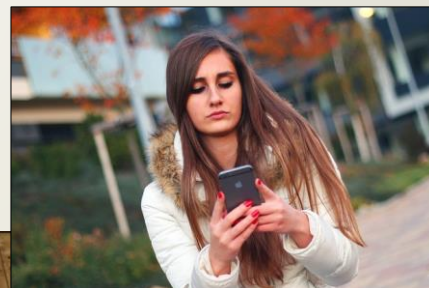


ASKACADEMIC

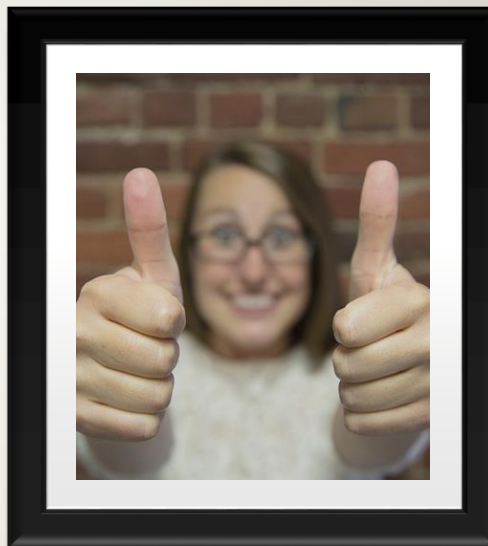

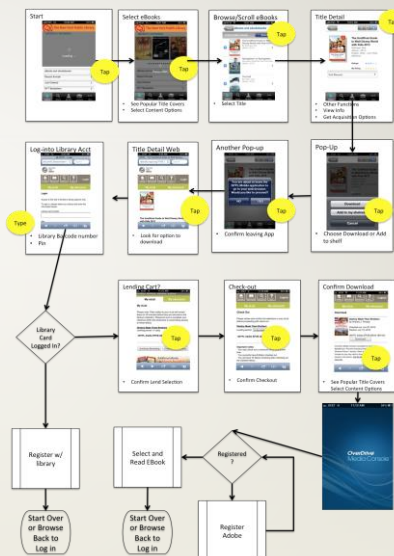

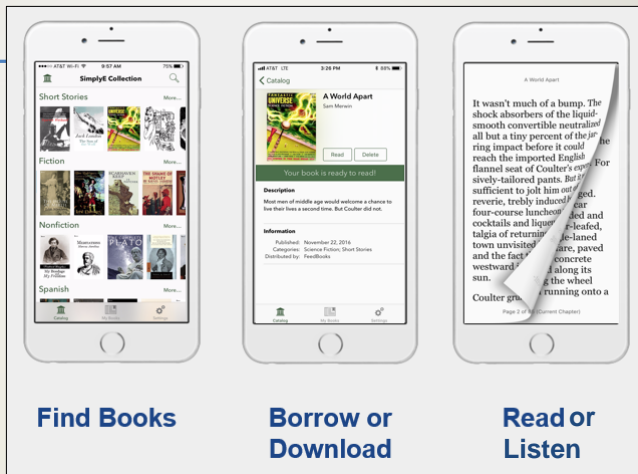
