## Mediation is Moving Forward

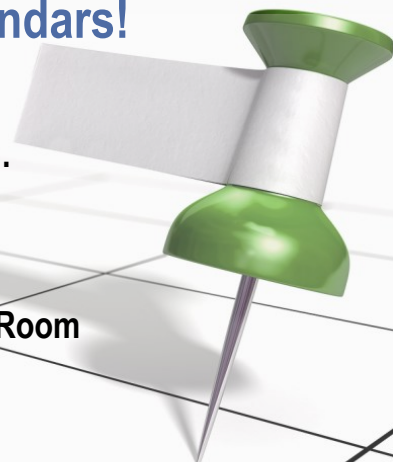
