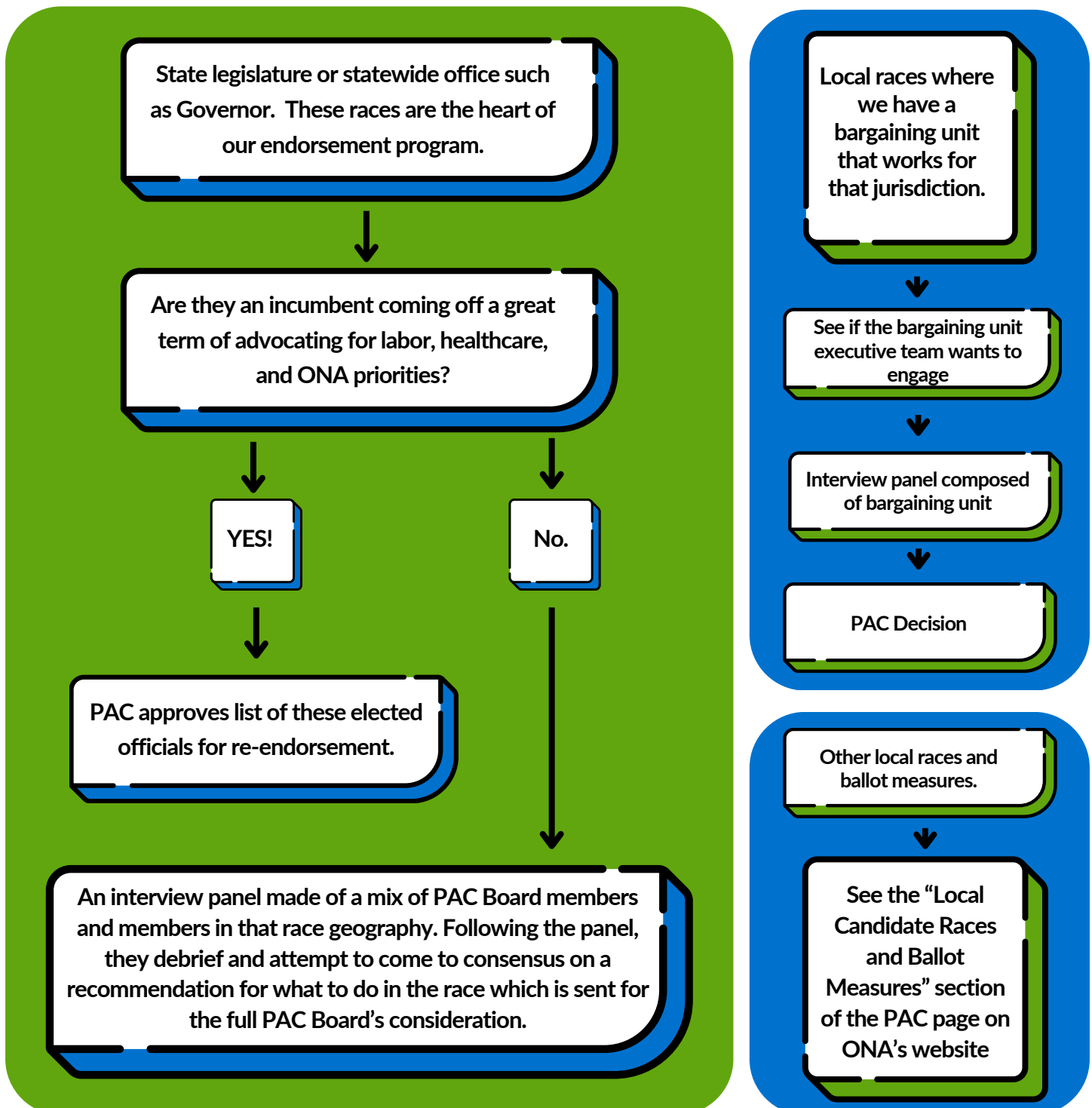


How Does ONA Make Endorsements in Oregon Elections?



ONA's endorsements are determined by the Political Action Committee (PAC) Board, a group of statewide leaders who convene to interact with candidates for office and make strategic investments in races where ONA's values (and gains for our membership) are at stake. The PAC Board is the ultimate decisionmaker in endorsements but who else takes part in the process up to that point varies by endorsement path.





What comes next?

After the decision that ONA will endorse a candidate, the PAC Board makes initial – and ongoing – decisions about how to spend PAC funds in support of the candidate. Finally ONA members engage in volunteer activities to support of the candidate, such as door-knocking, phone banking, event attendance, providing input to the campaign, and more.
