About

Named in honor of the late Dave Clark, longtime leader in Oregon parks and recreation, the David E. Clark Professional Honor Award is the highest recognition ORPA can bestow. The award is presented to an ORPA member park and recreation professional who has demonstrated leadership, inspiration to others, and has made noteworthy and special contributions over a period of time to the recreation and park profession. Candidate must have been active in the field a minimum of 15 years and have been a member of ORPA for at least 10 years.

Please prepare the following info to submit online:

1. Your Name, Title, Agency, Email, Phone and Relationship to Nominee
2. Nominee's Name, Title, Agency, Email, and Phone
3. How many years has the nominee been involved as a park and rec professional in Oregon?
Outside of Oregon?
4. Provide a short summary of the nominee's professional career in parks and recreation (2,000 word max)
5. List the nominees most significant accomplishments in parks and rec in Oregon (10 max)
6. Describe how the nominee has demonstrated leadership in the field of parks and rec in Oregon (2,000 word max)
7. Describe the ways in which the nominee has inspired others to excellence in parks and rec in Oregon (2,000 word max)
8. Provide a recap of the nominee's voluntary service within the parks and rec profession (1,500 word max)
9. Any other info about the nominee that you think should be considered (1,000 word max)
10. You must agree to submit a 2-3 minute video or slide presentation that highlights your nominee's achievements if they are selected.
