



Dr. David Reznik is Chief of the Dental Service for the Grady Health System in Atlanta, Georgia and an assistant clinical professor at Emory University School of Medicine.

He also serves as Director of the Oral Health Center of Grady's Infectious Disease Program, a program he founded 23 years ago.

Dr. Reznik is founder and President of the HIVdent (HIV Dent Alliance), and serves as dental director for the Mountain Plains AIDS Training and Education Center (AETC) and the Southeast AETC.
