Phi Alpha Delta Law Fraternity, International is a non-profit 501(c)(7) organization.

The International Initiation Fee (IIF) covers the costs of materials for chapters, membership pins, new member certificates, and general liability insurance coverage for P.A.D. chapters. Each initiation fee also includes a \$2.00 donation to the Phi Alpha Delta International Foundation, our 501(c)(3) charitable entity.

> Many professional fraternities charge a pledging fee, initiation fee, charge for pins or badge separately, annual national fees, materials, membership certificates, and more.
