This session will give an overview of how other libraries can take these ideas and modify them to meet the needs of their library.

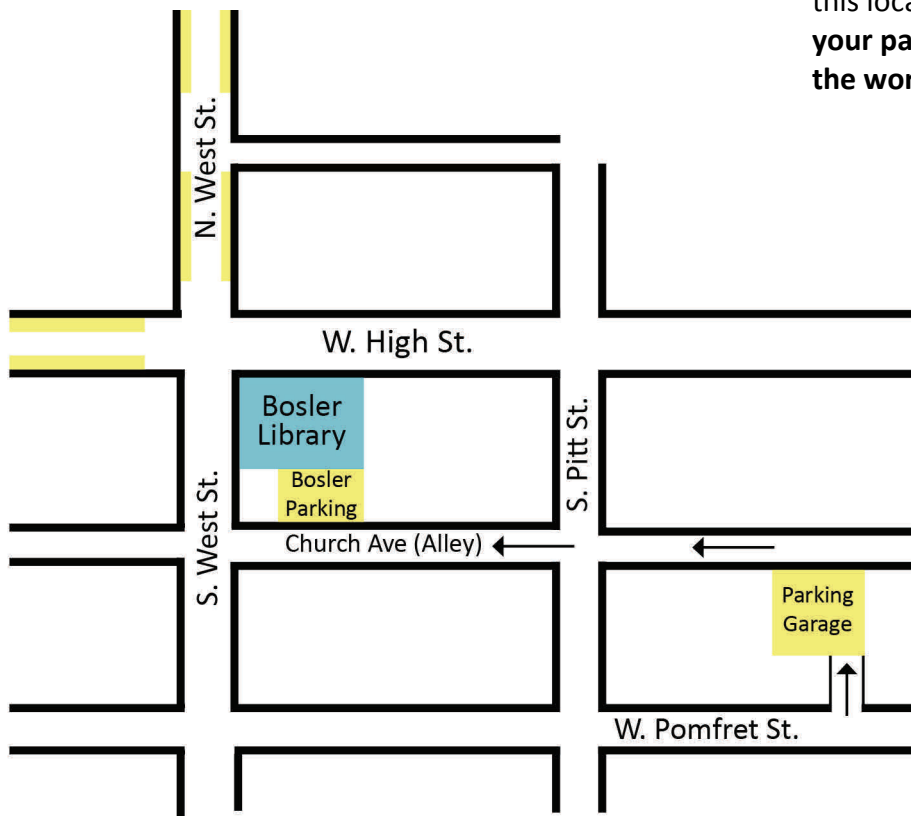
