PPA is proud to continue this new opportunity for students to gain valuable presentation experience along with the recognition for delivering a quality, short accredited CE program on a topic of their choice at a statewide pharmacist meeting. This is a very limited and prestigious opportunity and as such, has several important requirements. Only a total of four presentations, each of 15 minutes, will be invited for the delivery of a total of a one hour program on Sunday, October 21 at the Double Tree in Lancaster, PA. For the right, highly motivated student, this is an excellent opportunity to showcase your learning and skills.

Qualifications

- ✓ The student must be a P4 student (or the equivalent for LECOM), in other words in their final portion of their education, participating in their APPEs.
- ✓ The student must be a current PPA member and have been a member for the past year.
- ✓ The student must be from a Pennsylvania School of Pharmacy. (Or be from the ONU chapter.)
- ✓ Submissions must completely meet the Requirements listed below.

Submission Requirements

All submissions must include the following:

- ✓ Students' CV or resume
- ✓ Title of the presentation and one to three objectives presented in the appropriate manner, see [PPA program development guidance](#) for specific details.
- ✓ A brief needs assessment that illustrates a practice or knowledge gap that the program would help fulfill.
- ✓ A narrative or description of the presentation, two sentences to be used in marketing of the session.
- ✓ An outline of the intended presentation.
- ✓ A recommendation of qualification and an agreement to review the content prior to final submission and presentation on a form provided by PPA by at least one faculty member.

Submissions should be emailed to PPA's Director of Professional Development, Sara Bowden, at sbowden@papharmacists.com and are due by **May 15, 2018**. All submissions will be blind reviewed by a panel of five impartial judges. Invitations to those selected will be issued no later than June 30, 2018, with the final acceptance returned within one week. PPA reserves the right to extend the invitation to another student if the judges deem it is appropriate if an original invitation is not accepted within this timeframe.

Upon acceptance, student presenter must agree to:

- ✓ Register for and attend at least the Sunday portion of the PPA Annual Conference. PPA will provide complementary full conference registration but no travel expenses.
- ✓ Having a faculty member of his/her school also be registered and specifically attend his/her presentation during the conference.
- ✓ Submit a final PowerPoint, according to PPA CE guidance, of the presentation by October 1, 2017, sticking to the time frame of 15 minutes, including a small amount of time for Q and A.
- ✓ Submit a final consent from the faculty member who reviewed the presentation.

- ✓ Bring along a USB/jump drive of the presentation to use with the provided AV as a backup to the submitted copy.
- ✓ Comply with other required CE documentation such as the disclosure on Conflict of Interest.

The audience for the CE will be encouraged to submit to PPA feedback on certain elements of the presentation including content, organization, presentation style, etc. which will be provided to the student within one month of the presentation. Additionally, a certificate of appreciation will be presented to the student.
