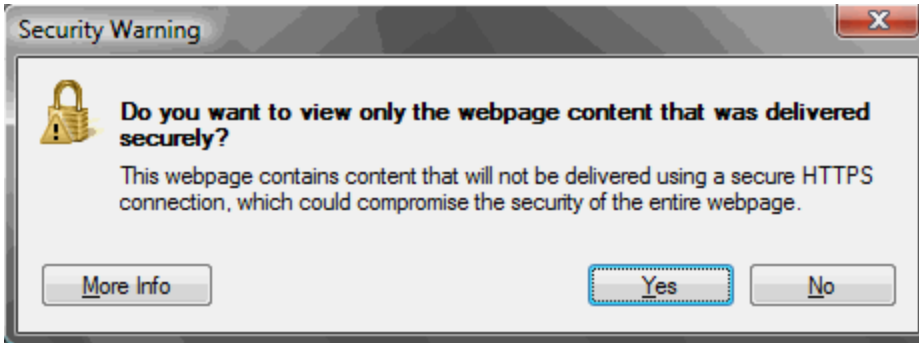
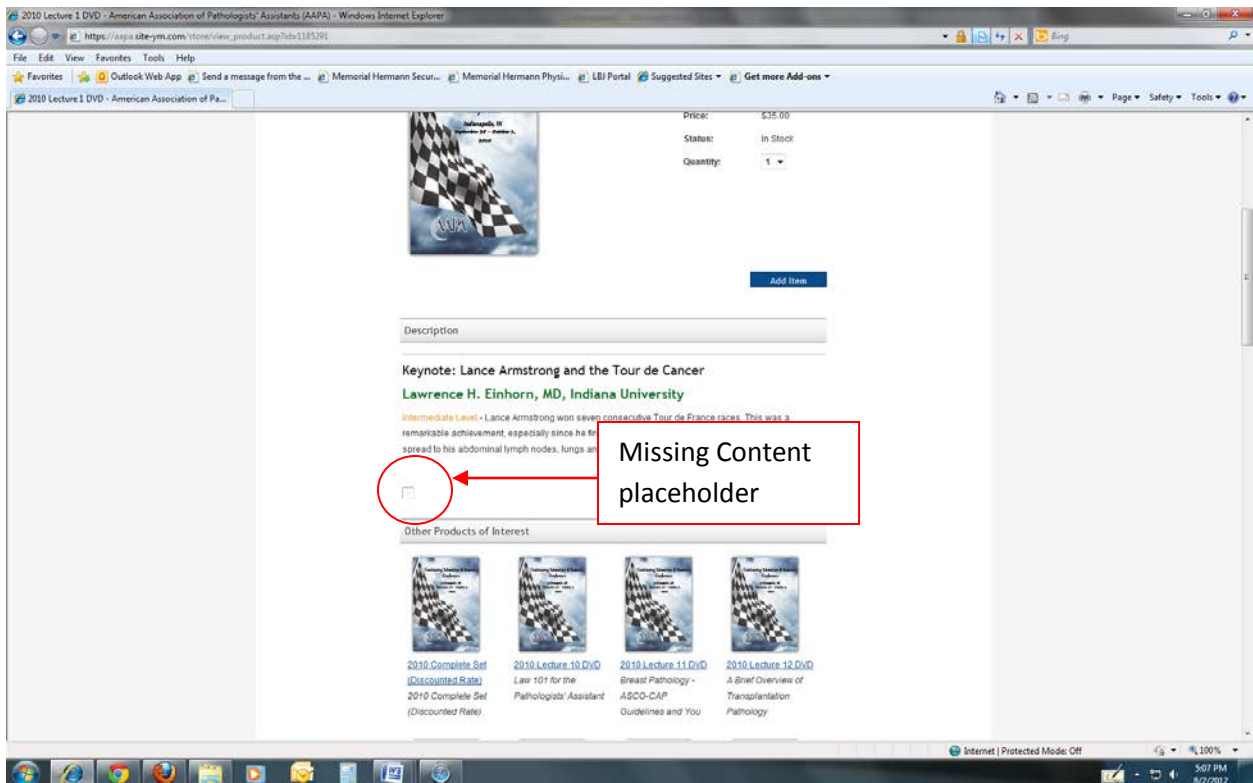


How to enable Mixed content in IE.



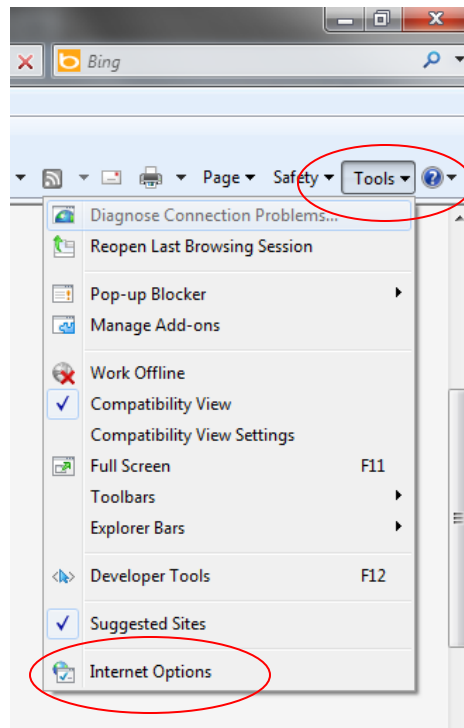
It is possible that you might get this warning in IE (Internet Explorer). The times you could see this are:

- 1) On an online Form with images (such as the conference registration form with images)
- 2) In the AAPA Store on some items with video content (ie, preview videos)

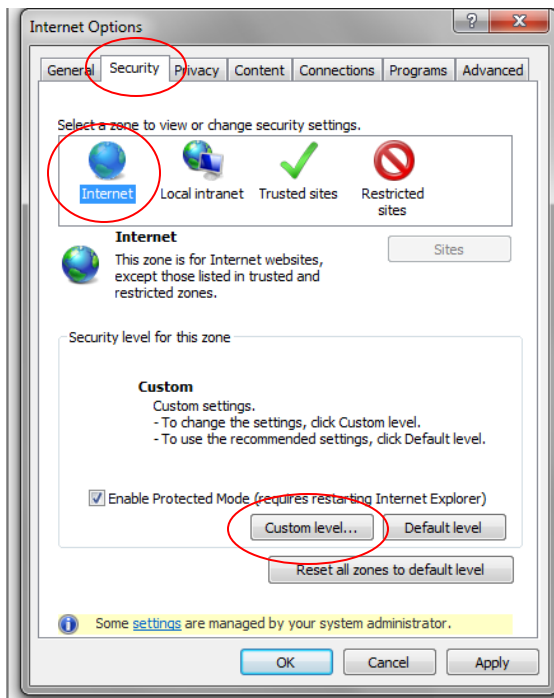


In order to see all this content correctly you must enable the viewing of mixed content. Here is how to fix it.

1. In the IE browser, go to the “Tools” menu and select “Internet Options”

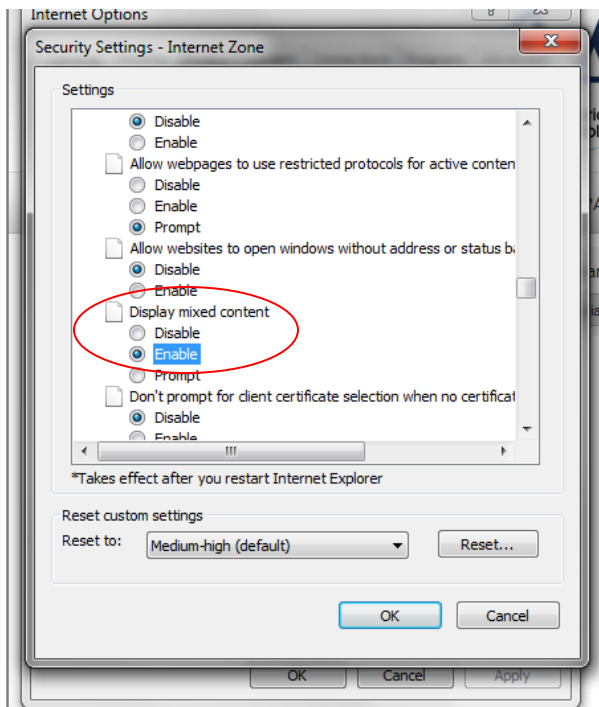


2. In the Internet options window, go to the “Security” tab. Select “Internet”. Then select “Custom levels . . .”

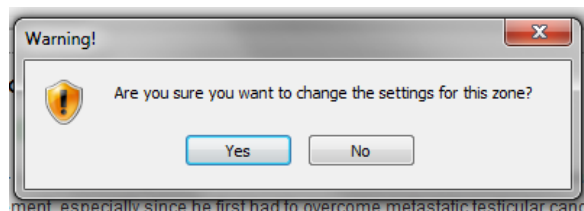


NOTE: Some institutions may have this disabled. If this is the case, you should try a different browser or contact your system IT administrator to see if they can enable the mixed content.

3. In the Security Settings window, scroll down to the “Miscellaneous” rules. Find the “Display mixed content” rule (7th rule). Select “Enable”. Click “ok”.



4. Select “yes” to the warning.



5. Then Click “Ok” to the Internet Options window. Refresh your browser (F5) if needed. And you’re done!
