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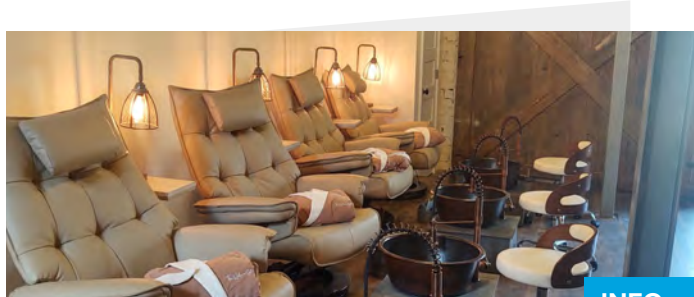
Gateway Center Arena

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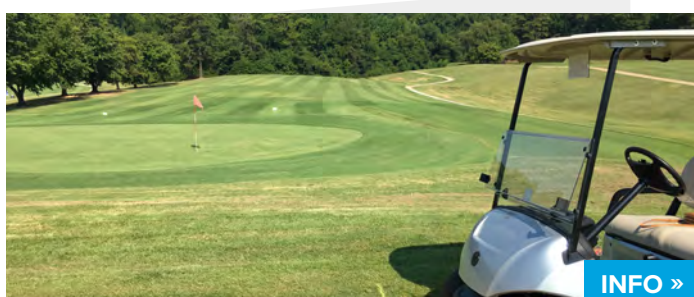
Academy Theatre

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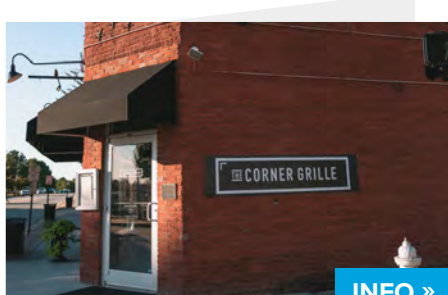
Historic College Park Golf Course

Black-owned and woman-led/ woman-owned Cajun-inspired spot with a private dining room upstairs.

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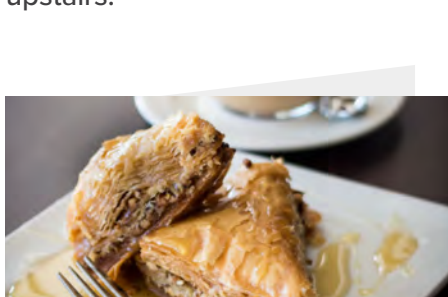
Virgil's Gullah Kitchen & Bar

Black and LGBTQ+ owned restaurant serving Gullah Geechee soul food honoring America's oldest Black culture.

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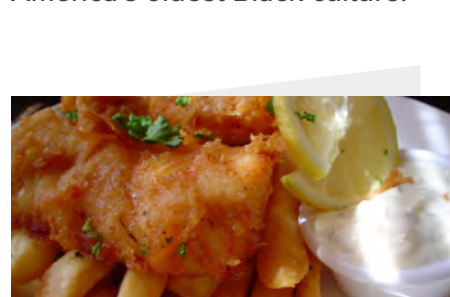
Aye Tea Elle

Located just off Main Street, this chic Black-owned restaurant serving elevated tapas is available for full buyout.

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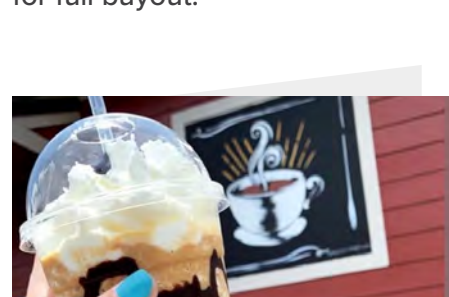
Bole Ethiopian Restaurant

A quirky woman-led/woman-owned coffee shop that offers a menu of light bites to accompany their artfully crafted lattes.

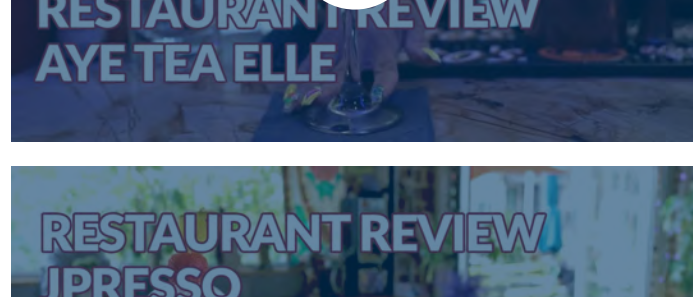
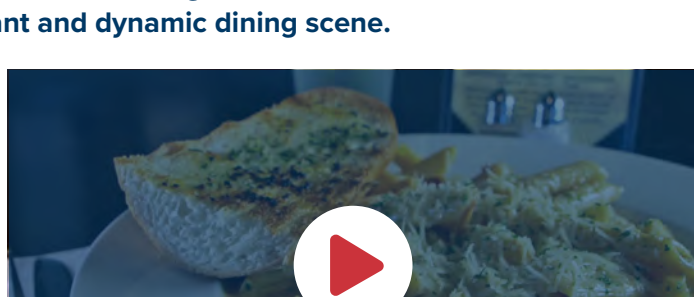
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Restaurant 356
