NOTICE REGARDING VOTING MEMBERSHIPS (Individual Voting, Agency Voting)

To register as a voting member, an individual must be currently licensed or approved by the authorized governmental agency within their respective jurisdiction to execute bail bonds for the public sector. A copy of one of the following documents must be provided to PBUS within ten days of application or renewal:

- Copy of active license from the Department of Insurance from the state authorized to write bail in;
- Copy of bail card authorized by a county sheriff or court from the state authorized to write bail in;
- Copy of authorization letter by a county sheriff or court from the state authorized to write bail in.
