- We have a comprehensive training program for graduating residents interested in pursuing additional clinical experience through serving the TBI/Polytrauma population across the spectrum of care (inpatient, transitional and outpatient) at the Polytrauma Rehabilitation Center in San Antonio, TX.
- This non-accredited 12-month VA Advancement Fellowship will highlight concepts unique to blast injury and focus on evidence based care for mild to severe traumatic brain injury.
- The rotation schedule roughly breaks down into 4 months inpatient, 4 months outpatient, 1 month transitional unit, and 3 months of elective (including rotation at San Antonio Military Medical Center, a level 1 trauma center in San Antonio). Rotation schedule can be customized once you have selected your next position.
- The TBI/Polytrauma Fellow will gain step-wise expertise in becoming an effective leader of an interdisciplinary team with the opportunity to mentor and teach residents and medical students as they evolve towards the role of Medical Director/Attending Physician.
