FROM TRAINING TO RESIDENCY LUNCHEON

The From Training to Residency Luncheon is an opportunity to gather current MD/DO-PhD and MD/DO trainees with directors and administrators of research-track residency programs. In each of the last three years, we have had nearly 300 trainees attend the program annually. The APSA Joint Meeting (JM) is the premiere conference to recruit high achieving research-focused trainees.
