All Board members are expected to attend Board meetings prepared to participate. Each member will receive a "Board Packet," via email, prior to each scheduled meeting. Each Board member must review the Board packet carefully before the meeting, especially the Minutes from the previous meeting. The Minutes from the previous meeting are a "consent item," meaning members will be asked at the start of each meeting whether or not they vote to approve them and whether changes to the document are required. PPGGNY Board culture values each voice as well as active listening.

PPGGNY's Board of Trustees meets on the third Wednesday of each month, from September through April, unless otherwise noted. Flexible language of the Bylaws has easily allowed for virtual meetings during the COVID-19 crisis.
