

Sign up for APMA Registry by March 24
Not too Late to Attest for MACRA 2017

Even if you have not done anything for the MACRA 2017 reporting period, it may not be too late. Review the list of 92 Clinical Practice Improvement Activities (CPIA) for the 2017 reporting period (via the link below). If you find that you performed any of these activities for 90 consecutive days in 2017, you can sign up for the APMA registry TODAY at <https://www.apma.org/registry> and follow the instructions on how to attest.

The deadline to **attest using the APMA registry is March 24**. Traffic to the registry and its support systems is expected to be very high at the deadline. Do not delay. Sign up TODAY!

Measures from this list that many of our members have performed in 2017 without even realizing they were performing a CPIA include:

1. Provide 24/7 access to MIPS eligible clinicians, groups, or care teams for advice about urgent and emergent care.
2. Performance of regular practices that include providing specialist reports back to the referring MIPS eligible clinician or group.
3. Annual registration by eligible clinician or group in the prescription drug monitoring program of the state where they practice, and more.

Again, if you completed any of these activities in 2017, you can attest to having completed them using the APMA registry (free for APMA members!). Not only to avoid a penalty in 2019, but position yourself for potential bonus payments in 2019.
