

Prospanica—The Association of Hispanic Professionals—has partnered with the Daniels College of Business at the University of Denver to create The Prospanica Board Leadership Program (PBLP). This program involves multiple touch points throughout the year: a two-day retreat at the University of Denver Campus, a summer-long series of webinars, and a two-day retreat in the fall at the 2019 Prospanica Conference & Career Expo in Orlando, FL.

The PBLP seeks to provide the knowledge and skills required to be a more effective professional, leader, and future corporate board member. Each member of this small and selective cohort will create an Action Learning Project that will act as both a lens and a real-world vehicle for their learning. The PBLP will result in an assessment-based Certificate of Board Leadership that codifies the depth of the learning experience. We've designed the PBLP to empower Hispanic professionals to know how to lead, both at their companies but, more importantly, as board members of national non-profits and eventually corporations.
