YOUR CHAPTER IRS FILING

On April 30, we sent an email requesting completion of Psi Chi's two-minute IRS Authorization Form to faculty advisors who had not yet submitted the form. The subject line was: "Reminder: It Is Time to File Your Annual Chapter IRS Information." The authorization form allows the Psi Chi Central Office to file the official IRS Form 990N on your chapter's behalf. If you have not already done so, please review that past email for your chapter's specific EIN number and complete the form as soon as possible.

Please note that you may receive an email from Simple 990, which is a company that charges \$40 to file on your behalf. Please do not respond to the email. Psi Chi will file on your behalf, at no charge.
