The purpose of this form is to transfer copyright in the Article from you and your coauthors, if any, to Psi Chi, the International Honor Society in Psychology, a Tennessee corporation, doing business as Psi Chi, publisher of Eye on Psi Chi. Please read this entire form carefully. It sets out basic information about the application of U.S. copyright law to the Article, including ownership and transfer of copyright and your ability to make certain uses of the Article following its publication in Eye on Psi Chi. If you have questions or concerns about the use of this form, please contact Psi Chi through its Web site at www.psichi.org .

Introduction. U.S. copyright law provides that the copyright in a work, such as an article, remains with its author unless and until that copyright is assigned to a third party, such as Psi Chi. All assignments must be in writing and signed by the author. Where there are multiple contributors to an article, U.S. copyright law provides that each contributor of copyrightable material (e.g., manuscript, tables, illustrations) owns an interest in the entire copyright in that article, not just in his/her particular contribution. Accordingly, to assign the entire copyright in an article, every contributor must execute a written assignment of his/her copyright interest.

The purpose of this Publication Agreement (this "Agreement") is to assign the entire copyright in the Article from all of its contributor(s) (each an "Assignor") to Psi Chi. The Lead Author shall distribute copies of this Agreement to every Assignor (i.e., writers, illustrators, etc.) and submit to Psi Chi a fully executed Agreement on behalf of each one.

Please consult the APA style manual for guidance on best practices regarding citing to, quoting from and other uses of third-party materials, including any written consents that might be required. Sections 3(e) and 3(g) below pertain to incorporation of third-party materials in the Article.

This Agreement shall become effective on the date when Psi Chi notifies the Lead Author that the Article has been accepted for publication in Eye on Psi Chi (the "Effective Date").

- Authorship.** Upon signing, lead Author confirms the following statements:
 - All authors are in complete agreement with the content of the Article.
 - All authors are prepared to abide by the policies of Eye on Psi Chi (see http://www.psichi.org/?eye_feature).
 - All Assignors have executed and delivered Agreements (attached).
- Assignment; Consideration.** Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Assignor hereby assigns to Psi Chi all right, title, and interest, including, without limitation, copyright, in and to the Article. In consideration for this Agreement, Psi Chi shall make

commercially reasonable efforts to publish the Article in Eye on Psi Chi.

- Assignor's Representations and Warranties.** Assignor represents and warrants to Psi Chi that: (a) the Article is original; (b) Assignor has all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement; (c) as of the date on which the Article is submitted to Psi Chi for publication, it is not being considered for inclusion in any publication not owned by Psi Chi; (d) the Article has not been published in whole or in part in any other print or digital publication; (e) the Article does not infringe the intellectual property rights of others; (f) to the best of the Assignor's reasonable knowledge the Article does not infringe any right of privacy or publicity; and (g) no royalties, honoraria or fees are payable by Psi chi to other persons by reason of Psi Chi's use of the Article in whole or in part.
- License Back.** Notwithstanding the comprehensive nature of this Agreement, Psi Chi hereby grants back to each Assignor a nonexclusive, royalty-free, nontransferable license to reproduce the Article in photocopies for classroom distribution; to post the Article temporarily to a password-protected computer network restricting access to members of the academic community where Assignor is currently enrolled or employed; and to make PowerPoint or similar visual aids in connection with oral presentations of the material contained in the Article (this "License"); provided, however, that Assignor shall ensure that in connection with any such use Psi Chi is credited as copyright owner of the Article and its original publisher. *Note:* From time to time authors desire to make uses of published articles which exceed the scope of the License (e.g., reproducing a portion of an article in a report on subsequent research, including an article in a textbook or scholarly anthology, including an article in a coursepack, placing an article on library e-reserves at an institution where the author is not enrolled or employed, posting an article to the Web site of a professional organization, etc.). All such uses require the prior written consent of Psi Chi and may in some instances require payment of a fee. Please address permission requests directly to Psi Chi.
- Miscellaneous.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes and cancels all prior agreements, written or oral, between them relating to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Tennessee respecting contracts entered into and performed within that State, without giving effect to such State's rules with respect to conflicts of law.
