Summer began and, in just over two months, the 9th Meeting of the European Society for Psychotherapy Research (EU-SPR) will begin in Rome!

Registrations are now open on [EU-SPR conference website](#). Please, remember that early bird rates are available until July 15th, 2022.

Poster presentations should be prepared on a format not larger than 80cm*120cm (A0).

Computers are installed at Frentani Center. Speakers are advised to bring their USB stick (verified virus-free), and to format their presentation in movie theater format.

Speakers of selected sessions will receive an e-mail in the next few days, asking them to sign the SPR form for use of recorded sessions related to EU-SPR Rome 2022. Please fill in the form, sign it and return it as soon as you can.

All speakers must be registered to the Rome 2022 conference before August 31st, 2022, in order to confirm their presentation in the final program, and to have their Abstracts published (presentations whose main speaker/first author is not registered by this date will be silently removed from the final program).

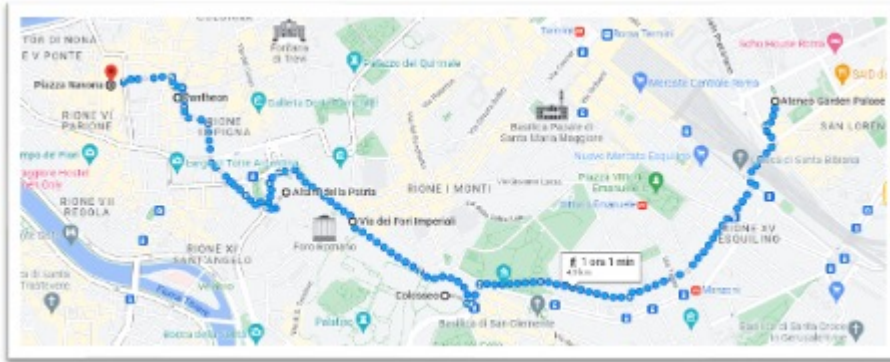

Pandemic situation updates

All Covid-19 related entry restrictions have been lifted.

- Green Pass: a Green Pass or equivalent certificate is no longer needed to enter Italy and it is no longer mandatory to show a Green Pass to access businesses and services in Italy.
- Use of masks: Until September 30, 2022 the use of FFP2 masks remains mandatory aboard most public transport (ships and ferries, trains, buses, buses/coaches used for chartered services with driver, local and regional public transport), whereas it is no longer mandatory on airplanes. The use of a mask is no longer mandatory for access to indoor shows and sporting events. However, the use of the mask in all indoor environments and in all cases of crowded outdoor events is highly recommended.
