He has published research and presented at national meetings on topics including advanced brachytherapy, sarcomas, brain metastases, emergency treatment of spinal metastases, and aspects of molecular oncology.

In his spare time he enjoys spending time with his family, running, and water sports. As a former lacrosse player at Harvey Mudd and Cambridge, he looks forward to teaching the sport to his two young daughters.


