Dr. Paul S. Brown is currently practicing as a Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgeon at Southside Regional Medical Center in Petersburg. He obtained his undergraduate and medical degrees from St. Louis University, completed a general surgical residency at Northwestern University, a cardiac surgical research fellowship at the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (National Institutes of Health) and his thoracic surgical residency at the University of Pennsylvania. He spent additional years training in the fields of heart and lung transplantation and pediatric cardiac surgery and is actively serving in the United States Army Reserve, Medical Corps, since 1993.

Prior to entering private practice, he served on the surgical faculty of the University of Texas and has authored many scientific research papers with presentations at national meetings in the fields of cardioplegic protection of the arrested heart, hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, hypoplastic left heart syndrome and radioactive ligand IL2 receptor blockade mediated immunosuppression to prevent rejection of the transplanted heart.

He is a Diplomat of the National Board of Medical Examiners, certified by the American Board of Surgery and the American Board of Thoracic Surgery as well as certified as a Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation. He is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (past Governor), American College of Cardiology and the American College of Chest Physicians and is a member of Society of Thoracic Surgeons, Southern Thoracic Surgical Association, American Thoracic Society and the Society for Vascular Surgery.

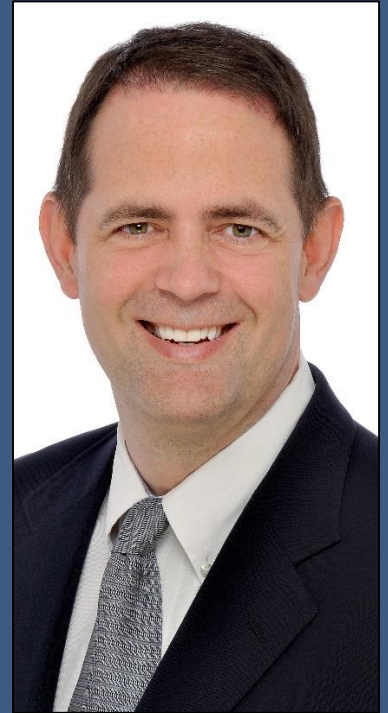
Over the past 20 years, he has performed more than 15,000 surgical procedures, including over 150 lung transplantations and 100 heart transplantations as well as assisted on thousands of other procedures. He practices the full spectrum of cardiovascular and thoracic surgery although his particular interests are aortic root pathology, coronary artery disease, diseases of the thoracic and abdominal aorta and lung cancers.
