The RMGCSA Legacy Award

Information for Applicants

General

The RMGCSA Legacy Award competition offers education aid to the children and grandchildren of RMGCSA members. An annual award of \$2500 will be funded by the RMGCSA and administered by the Board of Directors of the RMGCSA.

Applications will be reviewed by the RMGCSA Board of Directors (excluding affiliate liaisons). All decisions of the committee will be final. Application deadline will be May 1 of each year. Applicants will be notified of their status by May 19 of the year submitted. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant.

Eligibility

1. One or more of the applicant's parents or grandparents must have been a RMGCSA member for five or more consecutive years and must be a currently active RMGCSA member in one of the following classifications: A, Superintendent Member, C, Honorary Lifetime Member or Retired. The competition is open to natural or adoptive offspring of RMGCSA members. Children or grandchildren of deceased members are also eligible if the member was active at the time of his or her death.
2. The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning, accredited technical college, or other education related endeavor deemed appropriate by the administrators. In the case of high school seniors; the student must be accepted at such an institution for the next academic year. Graduating high school seniors must attach a letter of acceptance to their application.
3. Any number of students from the same family may apply, but only one student per family will be eligible to receive an award.
4. Awards may be granted to past winners.
5. Children of the current RMGCSA Board of Directors are not eligible for this scholarship.

Criteria for Selection

1. Applicants will be evaluated based on academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement, leadership and outside employment.
2. The student must submit an original essay of up to 500 words. The essay must be original and not previously submitted to the RMGCSA.
3. Financial need is not a factor in the selection.

How to Apply

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

1. Transcripts from all high schools and colleges attended.
2. Typed original essay (up to 500 words).
3. Graduating high school seniors must attach a letter of acceptance to their application.
4. Attach or email a photograph of candidate and RMGCSA member.
5. All applications must be postmarked by May 1st of the year submitted.

RMGCSA Legacy Scholarship Program

Your scholarship application will be judged by its appearance and content. It is important to remember the following tips:

1. Read the instructions carefully.
2. Request information that you have to obtain from others early. When your school will be sending transcripts directly to us, check back with the school about a week after you make your request to make sure your transcripts have been sent.
3. If you have questions, call the number on the application.
4. Try and have your application arrive as early as possible.
5. Provide all the information required. Do not submit an incomplete application.
6. Do not include extra items.
7. Proof all materials. Have one or two other people proof your essay. Use spell check.
8. Type your application. If you do not have a computer or a typewriter, go to the computer lab at your school.
9. Be neat. If you need additional pages to fully answer a question, use them.
10. Use white paper. Do not use staples.
11. Make copies of your finished application for reference.

Checklist for a complete application

- Carefully complete each question in application.
- Sign where indicated.
- Attach all official transcripts from any university and post-secondary school that include grades from the last completed semester.
- Attach required essay.
- E-MAIL DIGITAL PHOTO (WITH ADEQUATE RESOLUTION) OF SELF AND RESPECTIVE RMGCSA MEMBER TO INFO@RMGCSA.ORG.
- If you are a graduating high school senior, attach a letter of acceptance from the institute of higher learning you plan to attend.
