Military Experience

Retired from the Air Force in December 2008, with over thirty-five years of active, guard, and reserve service. My experience as an enlisted servicemember and then as a commissioned officer gave me experience and insight that allowed me to get legislation passed by Congress.

Additionally, after retiring, I worked as the Senior Legislative Advisor with the Department of Veterans Affairs which allowed me to have a lifecycle view of servicemembers from active service to veteran status. I completed 42 years of military and civilian federal service.

Community Experience

I believe in civic service and did that by volunteering with civic and non-profit organizations throughout my military and civilian career. My experience as President, Board of Trustees, Burke Centre Community, meant I was responsible for the same issues of policy, budget, personnel, and infrastructure that the Executive Committee oversees. As community president I managed over 5,600 homes with 17,000 residents.

For the past 20 years I helped the Dept of NCR to host the US Freedomwalk. The walking event was created in 2000 and each year welcomes teams from JROTC, the Boy Scouts and reservists from several countries. The event has been sanctioned by the American Volkssports Association and as a member of the International Marching League, Walking Association.
