Dear Congressman Langevin:

ROA supports H.R. 1049, "Department of Defense Emergency Response Capabilities Database Enhancement Act of 2017" to include National Guard and Reserve Component cyber capabilities in the Department of Defense Emergency Response Capabilities Database.

Given the increasing cyber demands of the armed forces and rising threat of severe cyber attacks, it is imperative for the DoD to know all their available sources in the Total Force. The National Guard and Reserve possess critical cyber expertise due to their participation in the innovative IT private sector. To fully utilize this talent, the DoD must know where these personnel are located and what type of cyber capabilities they possess. H.R. 1049 provides a simple and effective fix to better track these capabilities within the Guard and Reserve and allow them to be fully deployed in case of a cyber emergency.
