Policy Regarding Changes to Uniforms Resolution No. 16-01

WHEREAS, uniform changes are occurring more often across the military and uniformed services; and

WHEREAS, the cost of one complete utility uniform can exceed \$250.00; a cost that is usually paid by our service members; and

WHEREAS, some service members receive new uniforms at no cost, while others receive inadequate uniform clothing allowances, no allowances, or no clothing issue at all;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Reserve Officers Association of the United States, chartered by Congress, urge the Congress to direct that each time a uniformed service directs the wear of a new uniform or uniform item, that service shall issue free of charge to all affected personnel at least one complete set of that new uniform or item when changed and mandated for wear.
