### Resident Training Eligibility for all Participating Reserve Categories Resolution No. 16-23

**WHEREAS**, all participating Reserve Component (RC) member can benefit from professional military education and training to develop or maintain their competency; and

**WHEREAS**, many participating RC members are eligible to support missions via military personnel appropriations (MPA) tours; and

**WHEREAS**, AFI 36-2254, Volume II, Chapter 1, restricts many (i.e., category "E") participating individual ready reserve (PIRR) Airmen from taking part in active duty for training (ADT) tours; and

**WHEREAS**, further AFI 36-2254, Volume II Chapter 2, restricts resident developmental education (DE) to members of the Selected Reserve (i.e., unit assigned members, Air Reserve Technicians, Individual Mobilization Augmentees, and Active Guard/Reserve Airmen; and

**WHEREAS**, the Air Force and the other services can benefit from retaining highly skilled, trained, and experienced personnel who continue to participate while assigned to the IRR;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Reserve Officers Association of the United States, chartered by Congress, urge the Air Force to change policies to make all participating Reserve Component members eligible for active duty for training and resident developmental education.
