Dental Readiness Resolution 19-02

WHEREAS, dental readiness is a critical component of medical readiness for Reserve Component (RC) deployment; and

WHEREAS, there is a proposal by the Department of Defense to move actively drilling reservists as beneficiaries to the Office of Personnel Management Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP) for; and

WHEREAS, FEDVIP is not designed to support RC service members with dental readiness care that meets deployment standards; and

WHEREAS, outsourcing RC service member dental readiness activity to the OPM would result in the inability of Defense Health Agency to ensure the complex dental readiness of the Reserve Components is met;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ROA, chartered by Congress, urge Congress to legislate a total force dental program that includes the Reserve Component.
